

The applicant shall publish the notice in a newspaper having general circulation in the county or counties where a certificate of convenience and necessity is being requested, once each week for two consecutive weeks beginning with the week after the notice is received from the Commission. Proof of publication in the form of a publisher's affidavit shall be submitted to the Commission within 30 days of the last publication date. The affidavit shall state with specificity each county in which the newspaper is of general circulation.

G. Notice To Neighboring Utilities:

- i. List all neighboring retail public utilities and cities providing the same utility service within the following vicinities of the applicant's proposed certificate area.
- ii. For applications for the issuance of a **NEW** certificate of public convenience and necessity, the applicant must mail the notice with a copy of the proposed CCN map to all cities and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service within **five (5) miles** of the requested service area **EXHIBIT F**
- iii. For applications for the **AMENDMENT** of certificate of public convenience and necessity, the applicant must mail the notice with a copy of the proposed CCN map to all cities and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service within **two (2) miles** of the requested service area

H. Notice to Customers

Investor Owned Utilities (IOUs) that are currently providing service without a certificate must provide individual mailed notice to all current customers. The notice must contain the current rates, the date those rates were instituted and any other information required in the application.

I. The Commission may require the applicant to deliver notice to other affected persons or agencies.

Do not publish or send copies of the proposed notices to anyone at the time you submit the application to the Commission. Wait until you receive written authorization to do so. This will occur after the Commission has reviewed the notices for completeness, and your application has been accepted for filing.



A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.

On October 24, 2006, Mr. Don White of the Texas Commission On Environmental Quality (TCEQ) San Antonio Region Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced operation to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for public water supply systems. Enclosed is a summary which lists the investigation findings. During the investigation three outstanding alleged violations and one "Additional Issue" were identified for which compliance documentation is required. Please submit to this office by March 24, 2007 a written description of corrective action taken and the required documentation demonstrating that compliance has been achieved for the outstanding alleged violation.

In the listing of alleged violations, we have cited applicable requirements, including TCEQ rules. If you would like to obtain a copy of the applicable TCEQ rules, you may contact any of the sources listed in the enclosed brochure entitled "Obtaining TCEQ Rules."

The Texas Commission On Environmental Quality appreciates your assistance in this matter. Please note that the Legislature has granted TCEQ enforcement powers which we may exercise to ensure compliance with environmental regulatory requirements. We anticipate that you will resolve the alleged violations as required in order to protect the State's environment and the Public's health. If you have additional information that we are unaware of, you have the opportunity to contest the violation documented in this notice. Should you choose to do so, you must notify the Region Office within 10 days from the date of this letter. At that time, Mr. Bobby Caldwell, Water Program Manager will schedule a violation review meeting to be conducted within 21 days of the date of this

Failure to have maintenance and house keeping practices to ensure the good working condition and general appearance of the system's facilities and equipment. Specifically, there were significant water leaks documented at each of the two high service pumps at the Dallas Street Facility and there was a similar water leak on the discharge of the Mulberry well just downstream of the meter. Not only do these represent a serious loss of water from the system but the pooling of this water downgradient could result in the harboring of disease causing insects.

Recommended Corrective Action: Repair the water leaks from the high service pumps at the Dallas Street pumping station and the water leak from the discharge of the Mulberry Street well.

Please submit to this office by the Compliance Due Date, photographs documenting that these leaks have been repaired.

Failure to maintain intruder resistant fences in an uncompromised state around your well fields and ground storage tank facilities so as to prevent the entry of unauthorized individuals. Specifically, the intruder resistant fence at the elevated storage tank is overgrown with vegetation and is missing parts of the three strands of barbed wire. The intruder resistant fences at the Mulberry Street and Indian Waters facilities are compromised by tree limbs and excess vegetation growing on top of the three strands of barbed wire. The intruder resistant fence at the Dallas Street facility is missing part of the three strands of barbed wire and is also overgrown with excess vegetation.

Recommended Corrective Action: Repair or replace the missing three strands of barbed wire on the intruder resistant fences at the elevated storage tank and the Dallas Street facility. Remove the tree limbs and excess vegetation growing on top of the intruder resistant fences at all of the water production and storage facilities.
