Occupancy method: The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by the total number of occupants in all dwelling units at the beginning of the month for which bills are being rendered. Number of Occupants for Ratio occupancy method: **Billing Purposes** Number of Occupants 1.0 The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit 1 1.6 2 is adjusted as shown in the table to the right. This 2.2 adjusted value is divided by the total of these values 3 2.2 + 0.4 for each additional occupant for all dwelling units occupied at the beginning of the >3 retail public utility's billing period. Number of Occupants for Number of Estimated occupancy method: **Billing Purposes** Bedrooms 1 0 (Efficiency) The estimated occupancy for each unit is based on the 1.6 number of bedrooms as shown in the table to the 1 2.8 2 right.
