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APPLICATION OF LAKE LIVINGSTON WATER SUPPLY AND SEWER SERVICE CORPORATION AND TYLER COUNTY WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION FOR SALE, TRANSFER, OR MERGER OF FACILITIES AND CERTIFICATE RIGHTS IN TYLER COUNTY (37966-S)

COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Request for an Extension. Staff requests that the deadline for Lake Livingston Water Supply and Sewer Service Corporation (Lake Livingston WSC) to file corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps be extended. Staff requests that the deadline for Staff to file its recommendation on Lake Livingston WSC's corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps be extended from June 5, 2015 to June 19, 2015. In support of its Request for an Extension, Staff states the following:

I. Background

On June 30, 2014, Lake Livingston Water Supply and Sewer Service Corporation (Lake Livingston WSC) filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Lake Livingston WSC requested approval of the sale and transfer of its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN No. 10147) and the accompanying water system for the Wayward Winds Estates subdivision in Tyler County, Texas. Tyler County Water Supply Corporation (Tyler County WSC) is the purchaser/transferee. As part of the application, Lake Livingston WSC and Tyler County WSC also requested an amendment to Tyler County WSC's CCN No. 11528 to reflect the sale and transfer of Lake Livingston WSC's CCN No. 10147 and water system for the Wayward Winds Estates subdivision.

Effective September 1, 2014, the Commission began the economic regulation of water and sewer utilities. This proceeding, which was pending at the TCEQ, was transferred to the Commission for processing.

On May 12, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 7, which required

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Lake Livingston WSC to file corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps with the Commission by May 22, 2015. Order No. 7 also required Staff to file a recommendation on the corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps by June 5, 2015.

On June 3, 2015, Lake Livingston WSC filed its corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps.

II. Request for an Extension

The Commission's procedural rules permit deadlines to be extended upon a showing of good cause.¹ There is good cause in this proceeding because Staff needs additional time to review Lake Livingston WSC's late filing of its corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps. Thus, Staff requests that the deadline for Staff to file its recommendation on Lake Livingston WSC's corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps be extended from June 5, 2015 to June 19, 2015.

III. Conclusion

Staff requests that the deadline for Staff to file its recommendation on Lake Livingston WSC's corrected proposed notice and hard copy maps be extended from June 5, 2015 to June 19, 2015.
