COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Request for an Extension. Staff requests that the deadline for Staff to file its request for hearing or recommendation be extended from July 20, 2015 to July 31, 2015. In support of its Request for an Extension, Staff states the following:

I. Background

On June 30, 2014, Lake Livingston Water Supply and Sewer Service Corporation (Lake Livingston WSC) filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Lake Livingston WSC requested approval of the sale and transfer of its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN No. 10147) and the accompanying water system for the Wayward Winds Estates subdivision in Tyler County, Texas. Tyler County Water Supply Corporation (Tyler County WSC) is the purchaser/transferee. As part of the application, Lake Livingston WSC and Tyler County WSC also requested an amendment to Tyler County WSC's CCN No. 11528 to reflect the sale and transfer of Lake Livingston WSC's CCN No. 10147 and water system for the Wayward Winds Estates subdivision.

Effective September 1, 2014, the Commission began the economic regulation of water and sewer utilities. This proceeding, which was pending at the TCEQ, was transferred to the Commission for processing.

On June 24, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 9, which required Lake Livingston WSC to file a corrected small scale map by July 3, 2015. Order No. 9 also established July 20, 2015 as the deadline for Staff to either request a hearing or file its recommendation.

On July 7, 2015, Lake Livingston WSC filed a small scale map.

II. Request for an Extension

The Commission's procedural rules permit deadlines to be extended upon a showing of good cause.¹ There is good cause in this proceeding because Staff needs additional time to review Lake Livingston WSC's late filing of its small scale map. Thus, Staff requests that the deadline for Staff to request a hearing or file its recommendation be extended from July 20, 2015 to July 31, 2015.

III. Conclusion


Staff requests that that the deadline for Staff to file its request for hearing or recommendation be extended from July 20, 2015 to July 31, 2015.
