COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files this Request for an Extension. Staff requests that the Commission extend the deadlines established in Order No. 14. In support of its Request for an Extension, Staff states the following:

I. Background

Lake Livingston Water Supply and Sewer Service Corporation (Lake Livingston WSC) requested approval of the sale and transfer of its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN No. 10147) and its accompanying water system for the Wayward Winds Estates subdivision in Tyler County, Texas. Tyler County Water Supply Corporation (Tyler County WSC) is the purchaser/transferee. As part of the application, Lake Livingston WSC and Tyler County WSC also requested an amendment to Tyler County WSC's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11528.

On July 31, 2015, Staff recommended that the Commission approve the application and the sale and transfer transaction between Lake Livingston WSC and Tyler County WSC.

II. Request for an Extension

The Commission's procedural rules permit deadlines to be extended upon a showing of good cause. There is good cause in this proceeding because Staff needs additional time to create the necessary documents (e.g. service area map, new certificate of convenience and necessity) that would allow Tyler County WSC to serve customers in Lake Livingston WSC's formerly

certificated service area in Tyler County, Texas. Staff therefore requests that the Commission extend the deadlines established in Order No. 14 as follows:

Deadline for Staff to file its final recommendation	May 13, 2016
Response to Staff's recommendation Proposed notice of approval that includes proposed findings of fact, proposed conclusions of law, and proposed ordering paragraphs	May 27, 2016 June 10, 2016

III. Conclusion

Staff requests that the Commission extend the deadlines established in Order No. 14, and Staff also requests that the Commission adopt the proposed procedural schedule above.
