ORDER NO. 2
EXTENDING DEADLINE AND
GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE

I. Extending Deadline

On November 18, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a request for good cause exception to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8 which requires Staff to review an application for administrative completeness within ten working days of receipt. Commission Staff requested this deadline be extended to thirty days from the receipt of the application of the Town of Providence Village (Providence Village) to amend its water certificate of convenience in Walker County.

Commission Staff's request for extension is granted. The deadline for Commission Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and a proposed procedural schedule is extended to **December 8, 2014**.¹

II. Granting Motion to Intervene

On November 18, 2014, Mustang Special Utility District (Mustang) filed a motion to intervene and brief regarding administrative completeness. Mustang stated that it is dually-certified to serve the requested service area and the effect of granting the application will be to cancel Mustang's dual certification for the area within the town. Therefore, as the certified retail public utility that Providence Village seeks to de-certificate, Mustang is directly affected by the

application and thus has standing to participate as a party to this proceeding. Mustang's motion to intervene is granted.
