

The mailed notice sent by Porter Municipal Utility District ("Applicant") to Crystal Springs Water Company ("Crystal Springs") on November 19, 2001, notifying that entity of the above-referenced CCN amendment application, contained an incorrect address for Crystal Springs. Crystal Springs has represented to me that it never received mailed notice of this application.

To complete my review, please send a mailed notice of your CCN amendment application to Crystal Springs at its correct address in accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code ("TAC") § 291.106. Please ensure that the map of the proposed area sent with this mailed notice reflects your current revised proposed service area (and not the service area originally proposed).

30 TAC § 291.106(b)(5) requires that you submit an affidavit to the commission within 30 days of the date of the mailed notice specifying the person to whom notice was provided and the date of that notice. After you have properly mailed notice to Crystal Springs, please file a new "Affidavit of Notice to Neighboring Utilities and Affected Parties" with the commission specifying Crystal Springs as the person who received notice and the date mailed notice was given.

I will continue processing your application as an uncontested application if no hearing on the application is requested within 30 days after the required mailed notice is issued by the Applicant. However, if a hearing is requested by an affected person within 30 days after issuance of the mailed notice, I will refer the application back to the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") for a hearing.

Porter Municipal Utility District has filed an application to amend CCN No. 20573 with the Texas Commission On Environmental Quality to provide sewer utility service in Montgomery County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 7 miles north of downtown Humble, Texas and is generally bounded on the north by White Oak Creek; on the east by White Oak Creek and the Montgomery-Harris County Lines; on the south by North Park Drive; and on the west by the San Jacinto River. The total area being requested includes approximately 19,600 acres and 0 current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. 

Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.


If a hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to civil trial in state district court.



Dear Ron:

As you are aware, I represent the interests of Central Tree Development ("Central Tree") in the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") matter regarding Porter Municipal Utility District's ("Porter MUD") application to expand CCN No. 20573. Central Tree currently owns approximately 1,200 acres of property located north of Rolling Hills Drive and near the northern boundary of Porter MUD's proposed CCN. Pursuant to Greg Parker's testimony given at the jurisdictional hearing on March 25, 2004 and Greg Parker's April 28, 2004 map identifying Porter MUD's revised proposed CCN boundaries, it is my understanding that Porter MUD intends to exclude all of Central Tree's property from its expanded CCN No. 20573.

To the extent that Porter MUD intends to exclude Central Tree's property from its proposed CCN No. 20573, Central Tree is preparing to file a pleading withdrawing as a party to the SOAH proceedings on this matter. However, prior to doing so, Central Tree would like to be assured that, in addition to its intent to exclude Central Tree's property from its current CCN application, Porter MUD also has no intent to seek certification over this property in the future. Thus, this letter should serve as Central Tree's formal request that Porter MUD's Board of Directors take formal action to memorialize its intent to refrain, now and in the future, from seeking a CCN or an expanded CCN over the 1,200 acres owned by Central Tree, unless with Central Tree's consent.

If the Porter MUD Board of Directors takes formal action to refrain from seeking certification over the Central Tree property, without the consent of Central Tree, I ask that an authorized representative of Porter MUD please sign the duplicate original of this letter, provided herein, and return it to me for my records. Such signature will affirm that Porter MUD does not intend, now or in the future, to seek a CCN over any portion of Central Tree's property without Central Tree's consent (to the extent that Central

Tree continues to own the property). Additionally, such signature further affirms that the representative has been granted full authority to act on behalf of Porter MUD.

In consideration for Porter MUD's agreement to refrain from seeking a CCN over the Central Tree Property, Central Tree agrees to withdraw its protest to Porter MUD's application and to withdraw as a party to the SOAH hearing on this matter by use of the attached draft pleading. An authorized representative of Central Tree will sign this agreement as affirmation of its intent to abide by the conditions contained herein. Upon formal confirmation from Porter MUD that it has agreed to the terms of this letter, Central Tree will formally execute a motion to withdraw both its protest and its status as a party to the SOAH hearing.

MOTION TO WITHDRAW OF CENTRAL TREE DEVELOPMENT

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Central Tree Development ("Central Tree"), a party in the above-referenced proceeding, and files this Motion to Withdraw pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 80.115(b), and for cause would show the following:

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

Porter Municipal Utility District ("Porter MUD") and Crystal Springs Water Company ("Crystal Springs") each filed applications to amend their sewer certificates of convenience and necessity ("CCN") with the Texas Commission on Environmental

Quality (the "Commission"). Hearing requests were received by the Commission regarding each of these applications and a preliminary hearing was held on June 3, 2003 regarding Porter MUD's application (SOAH Docket No. 582-03-3043). The procedural schedule was abated on September 19, 2003, pending consolidation with the SOAH case regarding the application of Crystal Springs.

At the jurisdictional hearing held March 25, 2004 regarding the applications of both Porter MUD and Crystal Springs, and as memorialized in Order No. 1, issued March 29, 2004, Central Tree was granted party status.

II. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW AS A PARTY

At the jurisdictional hearing held March 25, 2004, and as recorded in the written transcript of that proceeding, Greg Parker, the District Engineer and authorized representative of Porter MUD, testified under oath that property being developed by Central Tree ("Central Tree Tract") would be excluded from, and would no longer be included within, the proposed CCN boundaries of Porter MUD. Mr. Parker stated that "it is [Porter MUD's] intent to exclude the properties identified [as the Central Tree Tract]" from Porter MUD's proposed CCN. See Transcript of Proceedings at 46. See also Exhibit No. Porter-1. Additionally, on April 28, 2004 Mr. Parker sent to the party representatives involved in this matter an updated map identifying Porter MUD's revised proposed CCN boundaries. This map depicted and therefore represented the Central Tree Tract as excluded from Porter MUD's proposed CCN boundaries. Finally, through a letter agreement between Porter MUD and Central Tree dated _______, Porter MUD agreed that it would not be seeking to certificate the Central Tree Tract at any time in the future.

Furthermore, at the jurisdictional hearing held March 25, 2004, and as recorded in the written transcript of that proceeding. Tom Martin, the President and authorized representative of Crystal Springs, testified under oath that the Central Tree Tract would be excluded from, and would no longer be included within, the proposed CCN boundaries of Crystal Spring. Mr. Martin affirmed that it is intention of Crystal Spring's Board of Directors "to exclude all of [the Central Tree Tract] from any proposed CCN boundary that Crystal Springs will seek pursuant to the proceeding." See Transcript of Proceedings at 51. Additionally, on February 18, 2004 Crystal Springs' attorney. Wendall Corrigan Braniff, sent a letter to Central Tree confirming in writing Crystal Springs' agreement to remove the Central Tree Tract from Crystal Springs' proposed CCN area. Likewise, during a pre-hearing telephone conference on May 27, 2004, Ms. Braniff certified on the record that when Crystal Springs submits revised mapping depicting the location of its proposed CCN, that the Central Tree Tract will be excluded from such proposed boundaries. Lastly, by letter agreement between Crystal Springs and Central Tree dated ______, Crystal Springs agreed that it would not be seeking to certificate the Central Tree Tract at any time in the future.

In accordance with the purpose and principal behind the requirements for notice and an opportunity for a hearing, neither Porter MUD nor Crystal Springs should be able to amend their pending CCN applications to include the Central Tree Tract, at least without reissuing notice to Central Tree as an affected party.¹ To this extent, and

¹ 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 291.106 requires notice to be issued for an amendment of a certificate of public convenience and necessity. The issuance of notice to interested persons on an administrative matter and affording such persons an opportunity to be heard are requisites of due process of law. See State v Crank, 666 S.W.2d 91, 94 (Tex. 1984), Texas Employment Commission v Cady, 563 S.W.2d 387, 388 (Tex. Civ. App.—Dallas 1978), and Thompson v. Texas State Bd. Of Medical Examiners, 570 S.W.2d 123, 130 (Tex. Civ. App.—Tyler 1978, write refused n.r.e.).

because both Porter MUD and Crystal Springs have agreed to restrict their proposed CCNs so as to exclude the Central Tree Tract, Central Tree's interest in this contested case hearing has been satisfied. Accordingly, Central Tree withdraws as a party to this proceeding. This withdrawal is based on the sworn testimony of Porter MUD's representative and all supporting documentation provided by Porter MUD indicating that it agreed to limit its CCN application so as to exclude all of the Central Tree Tract from such application. Likewise, this withdrawal is also based on the sworn testimony of Crystal Springs' representative and all supporting documentation provided by Crystal Springs indicating that it agreed to limit its CCN application so as to exclude all of the Central Tree Tract from such application.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Central Tree Development respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge grant this motion and any such and further relief as Central Tree may be entitled and as may be appropriate.

MOTION TO WITHDRAW OF SAM H. YAGER, III AND STARWOOD DEVELOPMENT, LLC

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Sam H. Yager, III and Starwood Development, LLC ("Starwood Development"). a party in the above-referenced proceeding, and files this Motion to Withdraw pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 80.115(b), and for cause would show the following:

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

Porter Municipal Utility District ("Porter MUD") and Crystal Springs Water Company ("Crystal Springs") each filed applications to amend their sewer certificates of convenience and necessity ("CCN") with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "Commission"). Hearing requests were received by the Commission regarding each of these applications and a preliminary hearing was held on June 3,

2003 regarding Porter MUD's application (SOAH Docket No. 582-03-3043). The procedural schedule was abated on September 19, 2003, pending consolidation with the SOAH case regarding the application of Crystal Springs.

At the jurisdictional hearing held March 25, 2004 regarding the applications of both Porter MUD and Crystal Springs, and as memorialized in Order No. 1, issued March 29, 2004, Starwood Development was granted party status.

II. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW AS A PARTY

At the jurisdictional hearing held March 25, 2004, and as recorded in the written transcript of that proceeding, Greg Parker, the District Engineer and authorized representative of Porter MUD, testified under oath that property being developed by Starwood Development south of North Park Drive ("Starwood Development Property") would be excluded from, and would no longer be included within, the proposed CCN boundaries of Porter MUD. Mr. Parker affirmed that "any property [to] the south of North Park Drive is not intended to be certificated to Porter MUD." See Transcript of Proceedings at 47-48. See also Exhibit No. Porter-1. Additionally, on April 28, 2004 Mr. Parker sent to the party representatives involved in this matter an updated map identifying Porter MUD's revised proposed CCN boundaries. This map depicted and therefore represented the Starwood Development Property south of North Park Drive as excluded from Porter MUD's proposed CCN boundaries. Likewise, through a letter agreement between Porter MUD and Starwood Development dated _____, Porter MUD agreed that it would not be seeking certificate the Starwood Development Property at any time in the future. Finally, none of the Starwood Development Property south of North Park Drive is located within the proposed CCN boundaries of Crystal FROM : PORTER MUNICIPAL UTILITY 'ST. PHONE NO. : 2813541088

Springs. See Crystal Springs Water Co., Inc. Application to Amend Sewer CCN No. 20906.

In accordance with the purpose and principal behind the requirements for notice and an opportunity for a hearing, neither Porter MUD nor Crystal Springs should be able to amend their pending CCN applications to include the Starwood Development Property, at least without reissuing notice to Starwood Development as an affected party. To this extent, and because Porter MUD has agreed to restrict its proposed CCN so as to exclude the Starwood Development Property, and because Crystal Springs' application does not include the Starwood Development Property, Starwood Development's interest in this contested case hearing has been satisfied. Accordingly, Starwood Development withdraws as a party to this proceeding. This withdrawal is based on the sworn testimony of Porter MUD's representative and all supporting documentation provided by Porter MUD indicating that it agreed to limit its CCN application so as to exclude all of the Starwood Development Property from such application. Likewise, this withdrawal is also based on the limited scope of Crystal Springs' application, which does not include any portion of the Starwood Development Property.

¹ 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 291.106 requires notice to be issued for an amendment of a certificate of public convenience and necessity. The issuance of notice to interested persons on an administrative matter and affording such persons an opportunity to be heard are requisites of due process of law. See State v. Crank, 666 S.W.2d 91, 94 (Tex. 1984), Texas Employment Commission v. Cady, 563 S.W.2d 387, 388 (Tex. Civ. App.—Dallas 1978), and Thompson v. Texas State Bd. Of Medical Examiners, 570 S.W.2d 123, 130 (Tex. Civ. App.—Tyler 1978, writ refused n.r.e.).

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Sam H. Yager, III and Starwood Development, LLC respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge grant this motion and any such and further relief as Starwood Development may be entitled and as may be appropriate.

's <u>Sewer</u> division <u>has</u> an existing CCN right in the middle of this area, <u>CCN 20906</u>, that was requested in <u>2000</u>, approved in March 2002 and is currently operating with an approved discharge permit capable of servicing up to 2000 customers

Crystal Springs Water Co., Inc., its parent corporation, Martin Realty & Land Inc., and developer partners own over 1500 acres in this area. We also are affiliated with landowners that own more than 2000 additional acres in this area. None of us have ever requested services by Porter MUD and were not contacted by them at any time

Crystal Springs Water Co., Inc. has the Sewer CCN, 20906, plus the water CCN for 4 water systems in this Porter MUD requested area. We do not agree to let Porter MUD have a CCN over our areas and will use legal methods to stop it

Please let me know immediately why this application is pending without proper notification to existing utility companies in this area plus why Porter MUD would attempt to monopolize most of Southeast Montgomery County, preventing other utility companies from serving their own customers, land owners, etc







Over the last several years, Portor Municipal Utility District (the "District") has received inquiries from various property owners and residents outside its current service area boundaries regarding sanitary sewer services. Some of these requests have been written and others have been verbal.

The District has received four (4) requests for annexation into its boundaries for the purpose of sewer service. These requests total approximately 144 acres and will provide services to approximately 500 single-family equivalent connections.

Additionally, there have been more than 25 verbal inquiries from property owners outside the current service boundaries. Several of these inquiries were made by individuals representing existing subdivisions with more than 100 properties in each.

There are an estimated 2000 properties within the proposed service area with private onsite sewer service systems. Montgomery County no longer permits the installation of conventional septic systems and now requires the installation of aerobic spray irrigation systems. The proposed service area continues to grow but is restricted by the lack of public sewer services. Consequently, the general need for service throughout the proposed service area continues to increase

The District has procedures to provide services to in-district and out-of-district customers. These procedures have been in effect for many years and are included as part of the District's Rate Order and Rules and Regulations.

To finance improvements to service the additional areas, the District will need to obtain voter authorization to sell general revenue and tax bonds of approximately \$350,000,000. The District is planning to hold town hall type meetings and conduct a bond authorization election early next year pending approval of this CCN expansion.
