<p>Notice is given to the public of the filing with the Public Utility Commission of Texas of an application to amend water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bell County, Texas.

<p>Docket Style and Number: *Application of City of Belton to Amend its Certificates of Convenience and Necessity and to Decertify a Portion of Dog Ridge Water Supply Corporation in Bell County*, Docket Number 43782.

<p>The Application: The City of Belton (Belton) filed an application to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Bell County, Texas. The effect of the proposed transfer will be to decertify a portion of Dog Ridge Water Supply Corporation's (Dog Ridge) service area. Belton proposes to amend certification of this area in order to provide adequate water service to the proposed Chisholm Trail West Subdivision. Dog Ridge has agreed to relinquish service to this area.
