ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Application

On November 19, 2014, Crystal Springs Water Company, Inc. (Crystal Springs or Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 20782 in Montgomery County, Texas.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On January 9, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's January 9, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo, Program Specialist, Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. Subst. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

In addition, Staff determined that Crystal Springs' proposed notice does not meet the requirements of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.106. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given an opportunity to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional

comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Crystal Springs' application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **February 20, 2015**, Crystal Springs shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff and submit a revised proposed notice. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **March 11, 2015,** Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
