ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Application

On February 9, 2015, Palo Duro Service Company, Inc. (Palo Duro) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 12200 in Parker and Wise Counties, Texas.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On March 11, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's March 11, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo and Suzanne Burt, Water Utility Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. Subst. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until April 8, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.



IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Palo Duro's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **April 8, 2015**, Palo Duro shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before May 12, 2015, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
