



This firm represents the City of Liberty Hill in the above referenced application. I am in receipt of your letter dated February 7, 2012, entitled "Notice of Deficiency." We appreciate the extension of time you have provided to allow the City to respond your request for information. In addition to the new maps, you indicated a desire to demonstrate need for the expanded CCN.

We are pleased to provide this information to you. The City recently acquired the Liberty Hill Water Supply Corporation to provide potable water within the City. Since the acquisition of the water system, the City has already planned to improve water service to its current customers as well as provide water service to the area within its requested service area. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is the "Water System 5-Year Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) Update" prepared by the City Engineer, Perry Steger. These improvements plan for growth inside the City's current CCN and for the area within the proposed CCN.

As a municipal provider of retail service, the City is planning for its long-term service and water supply needs to accommodate the eventual increase in population and water demands. Attached as Exhibit 2 is a portion of the Texas Water Development Board's Municipal Water Demand and Water Supply Information" for the Brazos – Region G Planning Area, which was last updated in 2011. The page included in Exhibit 2 demonstrates that the City of Liberty Hill's water demands will grow by 48% by 2020 and 107% by 2030. This demonstrates a remarkable growth in the City's water planning area, which includes the requested service area.

The need for the water CCN is evident. If you need further information regarding need, please let me know.

Additionally, enclosed as Exhibit 3 is a copy of a revised CCN map excluding the properties of Mr. Edward S. Butler; with Liberty Hill Land Partnership Ltd., Mr. William W. Soja and Ms. Deborah W. Soja; with Revocable Living Trust, and Ms. Ann Greenberg representing Liberty Hill Independent School District. The CD-ROM with the digital data for the map is included as well.

### Summary of C.I.P. Phase One and Related Recommendations

Phase One of the Capital Improvements Program for the City of Liberty Hill's water supply and distribution system consists of construction projects and improvements that are to be implemented within two years.

Project City's Cost

Trinity Sands Wells 6 & 7

\$251,000

Drill and develop wells for additional water supply. Construct necessary waterline extensions to connect the wells to the existing distribution system. The cost shown above is after subtracting a \$250,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program grant.

Install Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs)

\$34,800

Add VFDs to the existing well pump controls at Wells 2, 3, 4 and 5. VFDs increase the efficiencies of motors by reducing electric costs and extend the life of the motors.

Upgrade Supervisory Controls and Data Acquisition (SCADA) Components

\$76,000

New FCC regulations effective 2013 will require the replacement of the system's existing SCADA equipment. The new, upgraded controls will give greater control over the system's performance.

Trinity Sands Well No. 8

\$300,000

Purchase site and drill well for additional water supply. Construct necessary waterline extensions to connect the well to the existing distribution system.

Water Meter Replacements

\$60,000

Replace existing water meters that are leaking, inaccurate, or otherwise poorly performing. This project will help reduce water loss and improve system efficiencies.





I request a public hearing to discuss the proposed expansion of CCN No. 10324 for the City of Liberty Hill, Texas. I have not been contacted previously by the applicant to address the following problems.

- 1) The City of Liberty Hill does not have adequate resources or infrastructure to serve the customers within its current boundaries. Additional water supplies are not available from existing sources. Expansion of the CCN area to prevent other SUDs from aquiring the area is not justification.
- 2) The cost to serve the proposed **low density** area has not been discussed with the future customers. The cost of service may be prohibitive. If the system expansion and improvements are to be provided by grants or other means, to insure the benefits are affordable, this should first be discussed in local meetings.

The expansion of the existing CCN should include only that area which must, and can be supplied without major costs and new facilities. IE, the new high school.

As an owner of more than 25 acres within the proposed expansion area, I hereby reserve the right to "opt out" of the CCN if the above questions and concerns are not answered to my satisfaction. I own the following tax parcels: R023001, R392794, R095976, and R023002.


