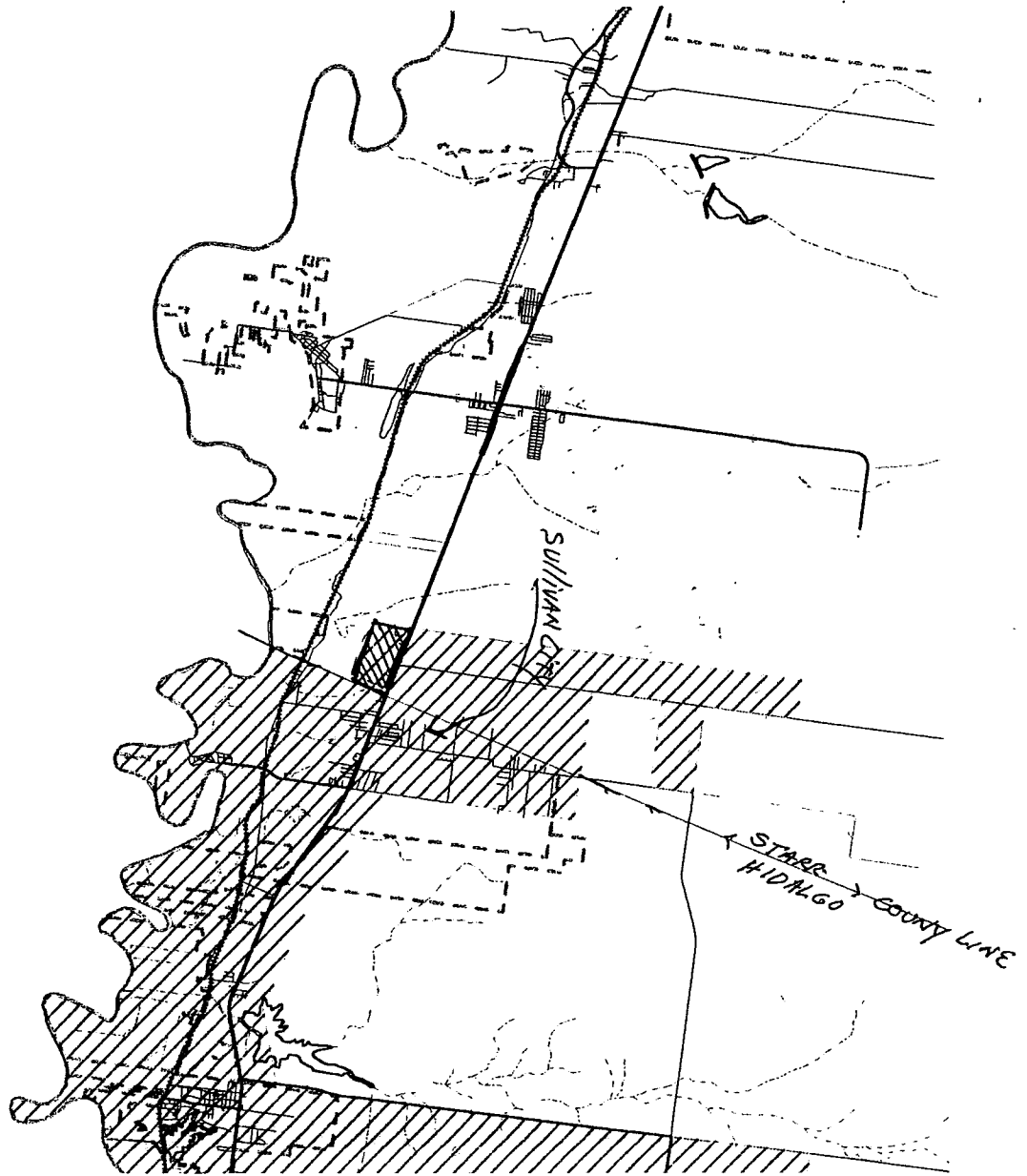


City of La Joya Water



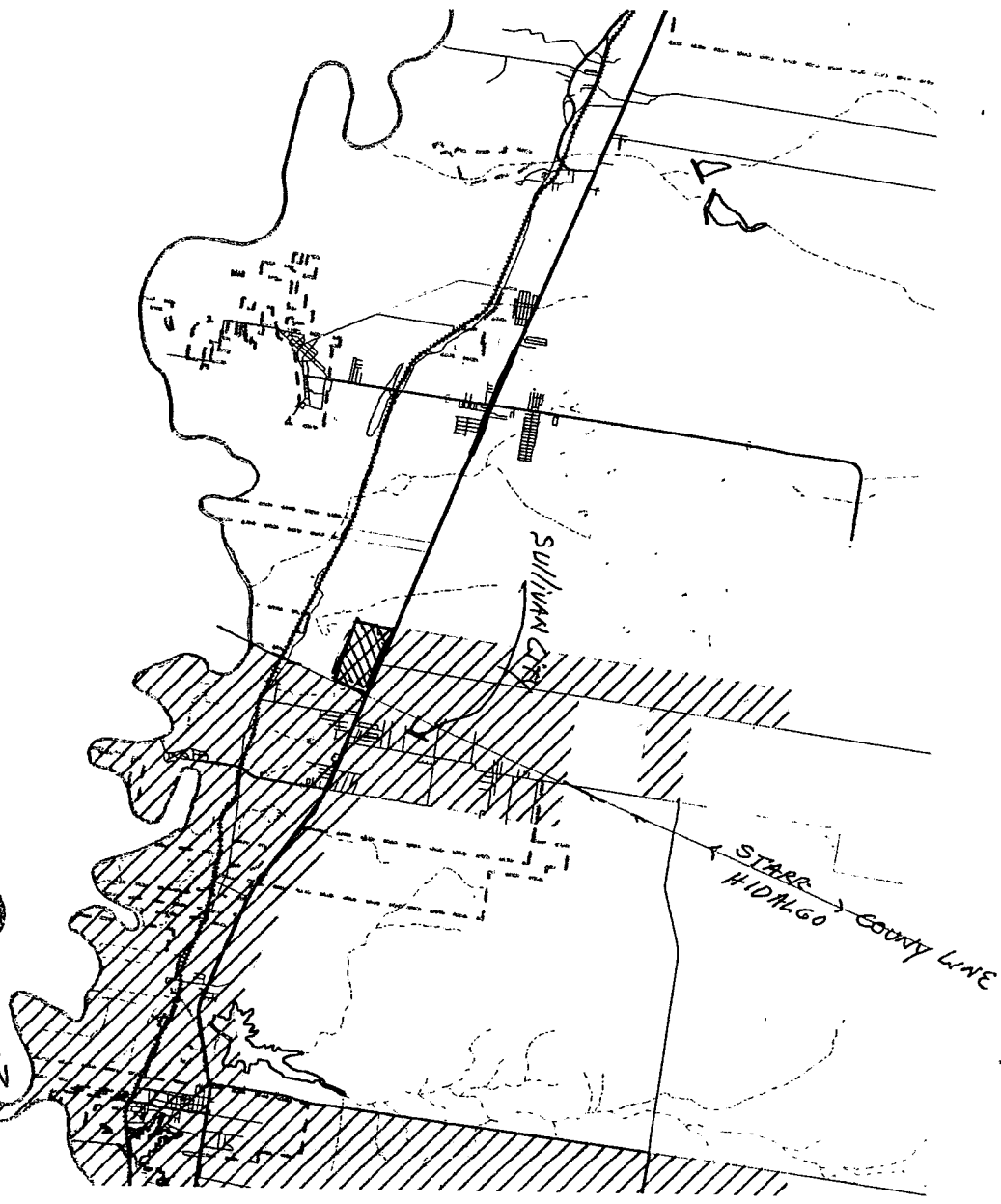
