VERANDAH COMMUNITIES, LP's MOTION FOR RESETTING OF
PRELIMINARY HEARING

The undersigned counsel for Veranda Communities, LP is also counsel of record for Southern Utilities Company in SOAH Docket No. 582-04-0083, TCEQ Docket No. 2003-0662-UCR. The Southern Utilities case is a highly publicized water utility decertification docket affecting several hundred people in rural Smith County now set for a local preliminary hearing in Tyler, Texas on December 2, 2003. Stories about that preliminary hearing have already been disseminated in the newspaper and television. The undersigned has been contacted by the local press for comments.

The Royse City and Verandah Community CCN preliminary hearings are also set on the same day at the same time 235 miles away in Austin. Obviously, the undersigned cannot attend both hearings. Given the scope of the notice already given in the Southern Utilities case, counsel for Royse City has graciously agreed


