I received notice today that the Royse City and Verandah Communities CCN applications have been set for preliminary hearing together on Tuesday, December 2nd at the SOAH offices in Austin. I have no objections to the consolidation of these dockets, at least at this time. However, in typical TCEQ/SOAH fashion, these dockets are set at the same time as the preliminary hearing in the highly controversial Southern Utilities Company docket 235 miles away in Tyler.
