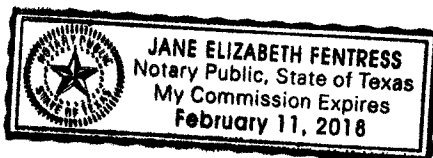

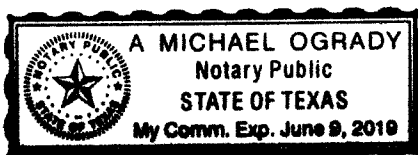

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER UTILITY SERVICE IN TOM GREEN COUNTY, TEXAS

Concho Rural Water Corporation filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for the provision of water utility service in Tom Green County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 6 miles west of downtown San Angelo, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by FM 2288; on the east by FM 2288; on the south by FM 853; and on the west by Pulliam Ranch Road.

The total area being requested includes approximately 28 acres and 5 current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

- 2) The Applicant include copy of a map showing the proposed service area with the individual notices to neighboring utilities, other affected parties and each landowner. It is the Applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ web site located at <http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/lwud/>.
- 3) The Applicant must notify **Upper Colorado River Authority** in addition to the neighboring entities listed in the application.
- 4) The Applicant be ordered to return within 30 days of the Commission order, a copy of the actual notice sent with attached signed affidavit that the notice was given.
