APPLICATION OF CONCHO RURAL WATER CORPORATION TO AMEND A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN TOM GREEN COUNTY

ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Application

On December 4, 2014, Concho Rural Water Corporation (CRWC or Company) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 11361 in Tom Green County, Texas.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application and Notice

On January 16, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application and notice is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's January 16, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Elisabeth English, Engineering Specialist, Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given thirty (30) days to address the mapping and notice deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, CRWC's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **February 20, 2015**, CRWC shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

No later than **March 20, 2015,** Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
