- ▶ **After your signed CONSENT FORM is received**, submit your application and the staff recommendation to the Executive Director for approval on behalf of the Commission.
- ▶ Mail you a signed copy of the order and CCN after it has been approved.

After you receive the signed order and CCN, you are authorized to provide utility service. You must

- ▶ Maintain a complete copy of your tariff at each utility business office.
- ▶ Charge only those rates and fees included on your tariff.
- ▶ Assist anyone seeking information on your approved rates or service policies.
- ▶ Make copies of your tariff available upon request at reasonable reproduction costs.
- ▶ Maintain a copy of the current Commission Permanent Rules, 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 291, in case questions arise regarding acceptable utility practices and policies.
- ▶ **NOTE:** These rules control the way you run your business and can be complex. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with them.

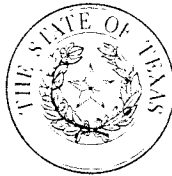
