EXAMINER'S REPORT

Procedural History

On October 14, 1977, Angus Water Supply Corporation filed an application a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for its facilities and service area in Navarro County. Included in that application was a map delineating the Applicant's present and proposed service area and the placement of its water utility facilities. Notice was given to all interested parties; however, none protested. The utility's current customers would not be adversely affected by the proposed certification. The Commission Staff has not objected to the proposed certification, and no party has requested a hearing on the matter. Therefore, it is the Examiner's opinion that it was not necessary to conduct a hearing in this case.

Based on the information received, the Examiner recommends that the Commission adopt the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and attached Order:

Findings of Fact

- Angus Water Supply Corporation applied for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide water utility service to the service area in Navarro County consisting of its facilities plus 200 feet from its distribution lines as shown on map WM 604.3-76.
- No protests to the application were received; nor was a hearing 2. requested by the Applicant, Commission Staff, or any interested
- 3. It is necessary to the service and convenience of the public that the Applicant be granted a certificate to provide water utility service.

Conclusions of Law

- Article 1446c, \$ 54(a) permits the granting of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity without a hearing when notice of the application is given to all interested parties, if any, and none object to it.
- The Applicant herein is entitled to a Certificate of Con-2. venience and Necessity under Article 1446c, \$ 54 V.A.C.S. to provide water utility service to the service area in Navarro County consisting of its facilities plus 200 feet from its distribution lines as shown on map WM 604.3-76.
- Any certificate issued to Applicant herein is non-exclusive 3. and is subject to amendment or revocation in whole or in part by the Commission.
