Dear Judge Wilfong:

Pursuant to Order No. 6, this is an update on the status of the above-referenced case. Double Diamond Utilities (DDU) has entered into settlement agreements with both the White Bluff Subdivision Ratepayers and The Retreat Homeowners Group. The agreements establish agreed water and sewer rates for the White Bluff Subdivision and The Retreat Subdivision.

The only remaining protestant group is The Cliffs Utility Committee. DDU and representatives of The Cliffs Utility Committee have exchanged information in an attempt to settle this matter, but have not been successful in reaching a resolution to date. As a result, DDU anticipates that the evidentiary hearing in this matter will be solely focused on the limited issue of the water rates for The Cliffs Subdivision. DDU requests that new dates be set for an evidentiary hearing on the water rates for The Cliffs Subdivision at a time that is convenient for all of the remaining parties.
