**ORDER NO. 4**  
**SECOND NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,**  
**ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

On January 23, 2015, in response to Order No. 2,<sup>1</sup> Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA or Company) amended its application to cure deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

**I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice**

On February 26, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is still deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's February 26, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis and Tracy Harbour of the Commission's Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

**II. Proposed Procedural Schedule**

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until March 27, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff.


**III. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient,  
Providing Opportunity to Cure**

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, GCA's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **March 27, 2015**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **April 17, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule..
