Please accept for filing the attached original and six (6) copies of an Application to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20465 held by Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA) in Chambers County, Texas. Also attached are two (2) copies of digital mapping data as required by Commission guidance documents. GCA is submitting this petition to voluntarily decertify a portion of sewer CCN No. 20465 to accommodate the provision of wastewater services to an area coterminous with the boundaries of Chambers County Improvement District No. 2 (CCID No. 2) at the request of CCID No. 2. GCA currently provides no wastewater services within CCID No. 2, nor does its current plans include the installation of the necessary infrastructure to do so. CCID No. 2, in turn, has obtained an agreement with the City of Baytown, Texas, to obtain wastewater services to its district provided GCA relinquishes its CCN service area at such location.

 - The applicant shall publish the notice in a newspaper with general circulation in the county(ies) where a CCN is being requested. The notice must be published once each week for two consecutive weeks beginning with the week after the notice is received from the commission. Proof of publication in the form of a publisher's affidavit shall be submitted to the commission within 30 days of the last publication date. The affidavit shall state with specificity each county in which the newspaper is of general circulation.
- G. Notice To Neighboring Utilities:
