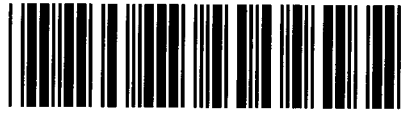

**ORDER NO. 7
FOURTH NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION
INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT**

On June 26, 2015, Commission Staff commented that the application of the Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA) is still deficient and not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's June 26, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis and Tracy Harbor of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

GCA should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, GCA's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **July 17, 2015**, GCA shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **July 31, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
