ORDER NO. 8 FIFTH NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT

On July 30, 2015, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation confirming that the application of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA) remains deficient and not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's July 30, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis and Tracy Harbor of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

GCA should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, GCA's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before August 17, 2015, GCA shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before September 1, 2015, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
