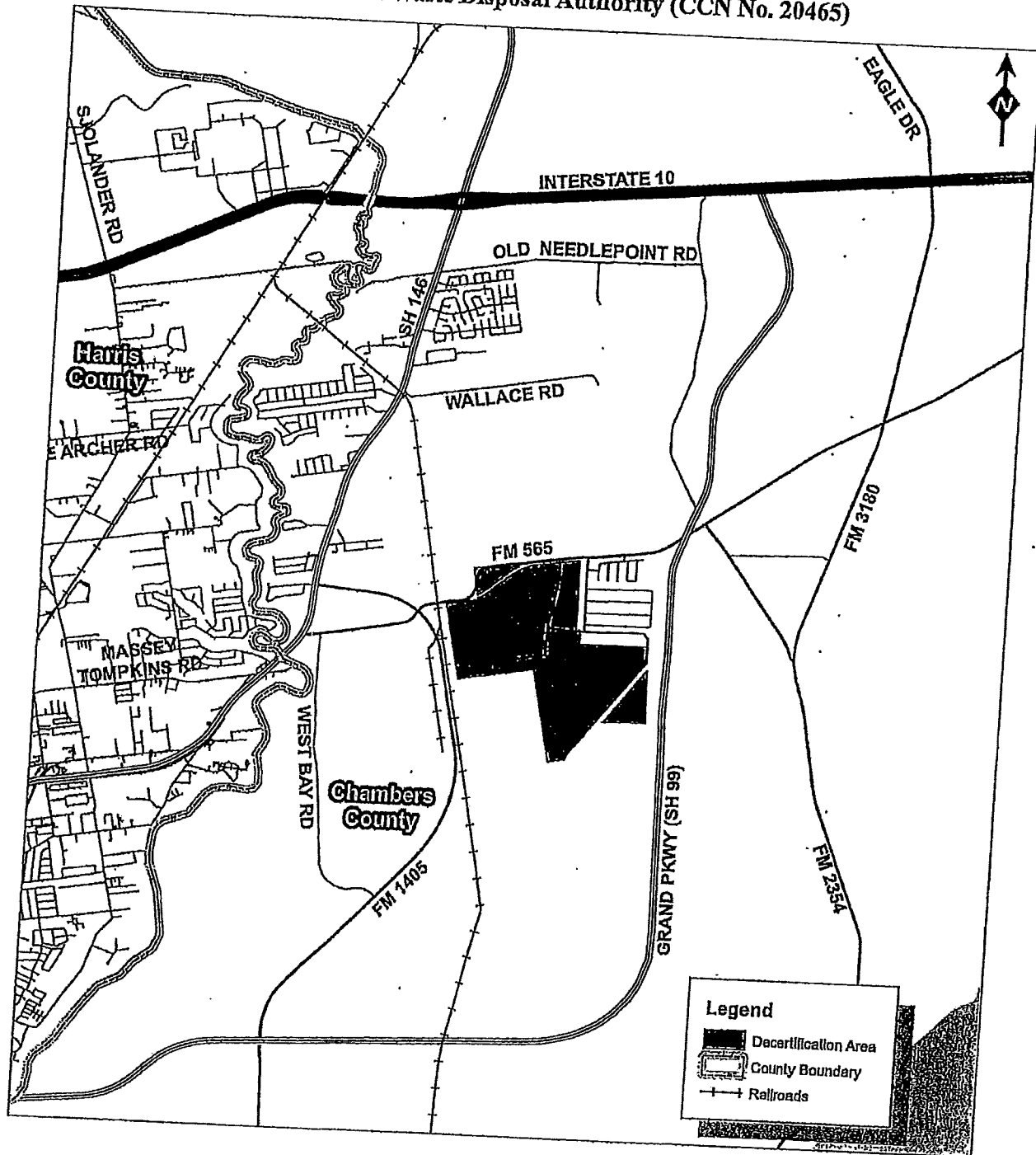

This application was submitted to the TCEQ on August 17, 2015. The application will be available for viewing and copying at the TCEQ control office, the TCEQ Houston regional office, and the Houston Municipal Library, 1501 Elizabeth Wilbanks Avenue, Baytown, Harris County, Texas, beginning the first day of publication of this notice. The facility's compliance file, if any exists, is available for public review in the Houston regional office of the TCEQ.

The executive director has determined the application is administratively complete and will conduct a technical review of the application.

PUBLIC COMMENT/PUBLIC MEETING You may submit public comments, a request for a public meeting, or request a contested case hearing to the Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below. The TCEQ will consider all public comments in developing a final decision on the application. After the deadline for public comments, the executive director will prepare a response to all public comments.

The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or ask questions about the application. A public meeting about the application will be held at the executive director's discretion that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application, if requested by an interested person, or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

After technical review of the application is complete, the executive director may prepare a draft permit and will issue a preliminary decision on the application. Notice of Application and made or amended, submitted hearing requests or are on the mailing list for this application. This notice will contain the final decision for submitting public comments.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING You may request a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court. Unless a written request for a contested case hearing is filed within 30 days from this notice, the executive director may approve the application. A contested case hearing will only be granted based on disputed issues of fact that are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application. Further, the Commission will only grant a hearing on those issues submitted during the public comment period and not withdrawn.

A person who may be affected by emissions of air contaminants from the facility is entitled to request a hearing. If requesting a contested case hearing, you must submit the following: (1) your name (or for a group or association, an official representative), mailing address, daytime telephone number; (2) applicant's name and permit number; (3) the statement "I am requesting a contested case hearing"; (4) a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the application and air emissions from the facility in a way not common to the general public; (5) the location and distance of your property relative to the facility; and (6) a description of how you use the property which may be impacted by the facility. If the request is made and the interests of the group or association seek to protect, must also be identified. You may also submit your proposed adjustments to the application/permit which would satisfy your concerns.

Additional notice will be provided. If a hearing request is timely filed, following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will set the application and Commission meeting. If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to the disputed issues of fact relating to relevant and material air quality concerns submitted during the comment period. Issues such as property values, noise, traffic safety, and zoning are outside of the Commission's jurisdiction to address in this proceeding.

2015 Property Tax Rates in Lee College District

This notice concerns the 2015 property tax rates for Lee College District. It presents information about three tax rates. Last year's tax rate is the actual tax rate the taxing unit used to determine property taxes last year. This year's effective tax rate would impose the same total taxes as last year if you own properties taxed in both years. This year's rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate the taxing unit can set before tax payers start offset procedures. In each case these rates are found by dividing the total amount of taxes by the tax base (the total value of taxable property) with adjustments as required by state law. BPD looking into armed robbery

On Wednesday at approximately 10:45 p.m., an officer was dispatched to Cheddars Restaurant located at 4530 Interstate 10 in reference to a robbery.

Upon arrival, the responding officer made contact with the 22-year-old victim, who stated he left work and was walking toward Raceway on Garth when a Nissan Maxima or Altima pulled up next to him.

The passenger pointed a firearm at the victim and told him to empty his pockets.

The victim complied and the subject, described as a black male, mid-20s, with facial hair and wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, red basketball shorts and dark shoes, took \$235 from his wallet and fled in the vehicle.

The driver was described as a heavyset white or Hispanic male, approximately 25 to 30 years of age with a tattoo above his right eyebrow.

The officer canvassed the area but was unsuccessful in locating the vehicle or subjects.

Aggravated assault

On Wednesday at approximately 11 p.m., an officer responded to the 4500 block of Larch Drive in reference to a fight.

Upon arrival, the responding officer made contact with the 22-year-old victim who stated while playing basketball with some of his friends, a vehicle pulled up and a male and female got out of the car.

The male and female began arguing with the victim and his friends about an earlier disagreement.

The female returned to the vehicle and retrieved a golf club, which she used to strike the victim in the back of his head.

The victim was taken to Houston Methodist San Jacinto Hospital by EMS for his injury.
