ADOPTING FINAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE


On October 1, 2015, Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA) filed an affidavit of notice, along with a copy of the notices sent, and an affidavit verifying publication of notice. According to the affidavits, notice was mailed to neighboring systems, landowners and cities on September 15, 2015, and published in *The Baytown Sun* on September 18 and 25, 2015. On November 9, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a proposed procedural schedule.

16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.107 (TAC) establishes a 30 day protest period following mailed or published notice, whichever occurs later. In this instance, the 30-day period began on September 25, 2015, and ended on October 26, 2015.¹ No comments, motions to intervene, or requests for a hearing were filed. The following procedural schedule is adopted:

Deadline for Staff's recommendation on final disposition.	December 15, 2015
Deadline to file joint proposed notice of approval.	January 15, 2016
