COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Extension of Time. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On December 8, 2014, Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCWDA or Applicant) filed with Commission an application (Application) to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20465 in Chambers County, Texas pursuant to Tex. Water Code. §§ 13.246(c), 13.254 (TWC), and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.113(TAC). On November 13, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 10 requiring Staff to file a final recommendation by December 15, 2015.

II. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Staff requests additional time to finalize its final recommendation. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline for Staff to file its final recommendation be extended to January 5, 2016.


III. CONCLUSION
