ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Application

On December 8, 2014, Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority (GCA or Company) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 20465 in Chambers County, Texas.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application and Notice

On December 22, 2014, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's December 22, 2014 filing and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis, Engineering Specialist, Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, GCA's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **January 29, 2015**, GCA shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule on or before **February 17, 2015**.
