



SOAH ORDER NO. 3 REQUIRING STATUS REPORT

On February 3, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) abated this case to allow the litigation in the First Court of Appeals to conclude. On November 28, 2016, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) informed the ALJ that the court of appeals had issued its opinion, judgment, mandate, and denial of rehearing in *Navarro County Wholesale Ratepayers v. Zachary Covar*, No. 01-14-00102-CV (Tex. App.—Houston [1st Dist.], June 25, 2015). The Commission also indicated that the Texas Supreme Court had denied the petition for review on April 15, 2016.

The period of abatement in this case is now concluded. M.E.N. Water Supply Corporation, Angus Water Supply Corporation, Chatfield Water Supply Corporation, Corbet Water Supply Corporation, and the City of Kerens, must file a status report and inform the ALJ whether this case should be dismissed or proceed to resolution. These parties must file this status report by December 19, 2016.
