# REMAND ORDER NO. 3 MEMORIALIZING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 17, 2011, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) convened a telephonic prehearing conference; all parties entered an appearance. Wiedenfeld Water Works, Inc. (Applicant) stated that the Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) had calculated the numbers based on the Commission's interim order. Those numbers did not support a rate increase. Accordingly, Applicant represented that the only remaining issues concerned the amount of the utilities' refund and the appropriate rate design. On or before May 2, 2011, the parties agreed to file a status report.

Presuming that the parties are able to agree on the refund amounts, the ALJ believes that the issuance of a Proposed Order on Remand is sole means of processing this case. Accordingly, the ALJ requests that the ED, in the upcoming status report, notify the ALJ specifically which findings of fact in the Proposed Order issued October 1, 2010, should be changed to incorporate the Commission's February 8, 2011 Interim Order and the ED's number running, which hopefully will include the refund amounts. If the parties are in agreement with the ED, the ED should so state. However, if the parties do not agree with the ED's suggested modifications to the ALJ's initial Proposed Order, objections and/or comment shall be filed within five working days of the filing of the ED's status report.
