8		treatment plant. A copy of Lindsay's permit to dispose wastes is attached to my

10		Additionally, Lindsay has three water wells from which it can provide water
11		service to its existing customers and approximately 304 additional customers.
12		Lindsay currently has approximately .25 miles of 3" distribution lines, 3.14 miles of
13		4" distribution lines, 3.98 miles of 6" distribution lines, 0.48 miles of 8" distribution
14		lines, and 3.41 miles of 10" distribution lines. The City also has two ground storage
15		tanks that are 30,000 gallons in size and two ground storage tanks that are 40,000
16		gallons in size. Additionally, the City has a 150,000 gallon elevated storage tank.

Based on the current capacity, the City is able to provide service to the entirety of the 18 Proposed Service Territory as growth demands.

1	Q.	HOW WILL THE ENVIRONMENTAL INTEGRITY BE AFFECTED BY THE
2		GRANTING OF AN AMENDMENT TO WATER CCN NO. 13025 AND
3		SEWER CCN NO. 20927 TO LINDSAY?
4	A.	The environmental integrity will be affected by granting the amendment of water
5		CCN No. 13025 and sewer CCN No. 20972 in that central sewer service will now be
6		available in the Proposed Service Territory. Additionally, potable water meeting the
7		State Standards will be provided to customers within the Proposed Service Territory.
8		A more thorough discussion on environmental integrity is previously provided in my
9		testimony.
10		
11	Q.	WILL GRANTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CCN IMPROVE SERVICE
12		OR LOWER COSTS TO CONSUMERS IN THE PROPOSED SERVICE
13		TERRITORY?
14	A.	Water and sewer service in the area will be improved by the fact that water and sewer
15		service will now be available in areas where it is currently not. A utility providing
16		both water and sewer service is currently unavailable in the Proposed Service
17		Territory. Additionally, Lindsay is not in danger of running out of water in the
18		foreseeable future and this type of certainty is an improvement in the Proposed
19		Service Territory.
20		
21	Q.	IS IT FEASIBLE TO OBTAIN WATER AND SEWER SERVICE FROM AN
22		ADJACENT RETAIL PUBLIC UTILITY?
23	A.	There are two (2) other public utilities within two miles of the Proposed Service
24		Territory. Lindsay Pure Water Company has protested the application. Lindsay has

the financial, managerial, and technical wherewithal to provide sewer service to the Proposed Service Territory. Lindsay Pure Water Company does not have the managerial or technical capability to provide sewer service to the requested service territory. It has no experience in providing such service nor has it shown a desire to provide sewer service. There is no other utility providing centralized sewer service in the Proposed Service Territory.

Regarding the provision of water service, Lindsay's system is more reliable and, thus, in my opinion, there is no feasible alternative for water service in the Proposed Service Territory. Eurthermore, Lindsay-Pure Water Company has not shown a good faith effort to comply with the terms of the Settlement Agreement they sought to have executed in a previous docket where they protested an expansion of Lindsay's CCN. Lindsay Pure Water Company has made no attempts to amend its CCN to seek any of the area now being requested by Lindsay.

The City of Gainesville has not protested Lindsay's CCN application.

## 7 Q. PLEASE EXPLAIN.

The new rules require that for an amended application, Lindsay should demonstrate that it possesses the financial, managerial and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service to its Proposed Service Territory. All the criteria explained above would serve to establish that Lindsay has the managerial and technical ability to provide continuous and adequate service to Lindsay's Proposed Service Territory. The testimony provided by the Hon. Don Metzler, Mayor *Pro Tempore*, and Mr. Jack Stowe establish that Lindsay has the financial and managerial ability to provide continuous and adequate service to Lindsay's Proposed Service Territory.

Additionally, Lindsay should establish that the water it provides meets the requirements of Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 341 and Commission rules. Lindsay's most recent public drinking water evaluation establishes that it meets the standards for potablity. Thus, compliance with Chapter 341 is established. Additionally, Lindsay, as discussed above, has an adequate supply of water to meet its current water needs and the needs for the foreseeable future. Lindsay is in an excellent position to meet its water needs.

1	For sewer service, Lindsay should establish that it meets the Commission's
2	design criteria for sewer treatment plants, Commission rules, and the Texas Water
3	Code. As detailed in the sewer system analysis, Lindsay meets these requirements.

# 5 Q. ARE THERE ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS THAT YOU WOULD NEED 6 TO EVALUATE? IF SO, PLEASE EXPLAIN.

A centralized sewer system is preferable, 20 from an environmental standpoint, in that the wastewater is treated to a higher 21 standard, there is a lower probability of groundwater and surface water contamination 22 and with the discharge of treated wastewater from a centralized sewer system instream flows are created and maintained for aquatic life and other uses downstream. 23

According to your letter dated April 29, 2008, the alleged violation reported after the March 10, 2008 visit, was "failure to prevent an unauthorized discharge at the wastewater treatment plant". During the visit, the investigator told the plant operator that the discharge problem pertained to the racetrack not the oxidation pond.

The problem occurred because of a heavy rainfall the weekend prior to the visit. The heavy rainwater runoff turned the grease in the lift station and lines loose. When the plant was checked the next day the bar screen was covered with grease so the staff cleaned the screen. The grease turning loose put a heavy flow on the racetrack and may have caused some overflow. The bar screen is checked and cleaned daily to prevent a grease buildup that could cause problems. As no evidence of overflow has been noted by the staff since we instigated these procedures, we feel that this has remedied the situation so that no problem will occur in the future.

#### SETTLEMENT ACREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement (the AAgreement®) is entered into between the Town of Lindsay, Texas (ALindsay®), Walter Lutkenhaus (ALutkenhaus®), and Lindsay Pure Water Company (the ACompany®) as of the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2002.

#### Recitals

- Lindsay, Lutkenhaus and the Company are parties to a proceeding before the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (ATNRCC®) pending at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (ASOAH®) as Docket No. 582-02-0431 (ADocket No. 582-02-0431").
- 2. In Docket No. 582-02-0431, Lindsay has applied for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (ACCN®) to enable it to provide retail water and wastewater services in an area described in Lindsay=s application (the AApplication®). The Company and Lutkenhaus have each filed protests to Lindsay=s application.
- 3. The Company intends to file an application with the TNRCC to amend its existing CCN for retail water service. The Company=s application will seek certification of certain areas that are included in Lindsay=s application pending before SOAH.
- 4. As a result of negotiations between the parties, Lindsay has agreed to amend its CCN application such that it will no longer seek certification for retail water service to that area shown on Exhibit A, generally being described as south of Highway 82, west of the most westerly portion of Lindsay=s extraterritorial jurisdiction, and south of the most southerly boundary of Lindsay=s city limits, all as more particularly described on Exhibit A (the ACompany Area@). Lindsay has further agreed to not protest, either directly or indirectly, the Company=s application to amend its CCN, provided the Company seeks to expand its area of retail water service certification to include the Company Area only.
- 5. As a result of negotiations between the parties, the Company and Lutkenhaus have agreed to withdraw their respective protests of Lindsay=s CCN application pending as Docket No. 582-02-0431, provided the application is amended such that Lindsay shall not seek retail water certification of the Company Area.
- 6. The parties desire to enter into this Agreement to reflect their agreements concerning certification of the area set forth in Exhibit Λ, and in connection therewith, to fully settle and compromise all matters in dispute between them related to Docket No. 582-

02-0431, the Company=s CCN application, and certain other disputes as referenced herein.

#### Agreement

- Lindsay agrees to amend the CCN Application that is the subject of Docket No.
  582-02-0431 such that it shall not seek certification for retail water service for the
  Company Area depicted on Exhibit A. Lindsay shall file such amendment within 10
  days of the date of execution of this Agreement by both parties.
- 2. The Company agrees to file an application with the TNRCC to amend its existing CCN for retail water service such that it will seek single certification for retail water service for the Company Area depicted on Exhibit A. The Company agrees to file such application within 10 days of the date of execution of this Agreement by the parties.
- 3. Lindsay agrees that it will not protest, directly or indirectly, or cause the protest of Company=s application, as described in paragraph 2 above.
- 4. The Company and Lutkenhaus mutually agree to withdraw their respective protests and requests for hearing with respect to Lindsay=s CCN application that is the subject of Docket No. 582-02-0431 within ten (10) days of receipt of notice that Lindsay has amended the application in accordance with paragraph 1 above.
- 5. If the Company provides retail water service within the Company Area, and Lindsay provides retail wastewater service within the area where the Company provides such retail water service, then the Company agrees to enter into an agreement with Lindsay to terminate water service in the event wastewater bills of the Company-s retail water customer owed to Lindsay are not paid timely in accordance with Lindsay-s service policies.
- 6. This Agreement shall in no manner restrict or compromise the right or ability of Lindsay or the Company to apply to the TNRCC in the future for certification to provide retail water or wastewater service in areas other than depicted on Exhibit A attached hereto. Similarly, either party may protest such subsequent applications that may be filed.
- 7. The parties agree to take all other actions necessary or convenient in connection with implementing this Agreement.
- 8. In the event that Lindsay executes this Agreement, together with the Company or Lutkenhaus, but not both of the protestants, the failure by such protestant will not

prevent this Agreement from being binding upon Lindsay and the executing protestant for all intents and purposes.


