



COMES NOW, the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (ED), and files its Motion for Continuance of the Preliminary Conference to Formulate Hearing Schedule in the above referenced docket, and respectfully shows the following:

- On November 13, 2003, Judge James Norman of the State Office Of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") issued Order No. 18 which sets a preliminary conference to formulate a hearing schedule on November 24, 2003 at 9:00 a.m.

- The Executive Director has contacted counsel and all parties on the mailing list regarding this request for continuance.
