EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 12

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

The Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("Commission" or "TCEQ") is opposed to the submittal of a certified question to the Commission on the issue of Mahard Egg Farm, Inc.'s and Prosper Independent School District's party status. While the Executive Director disagrees with the Administrative Law Judge's ruling admitting these parties, the law is not ambiguous on the issue and does not warrant commission interpretation. Furthermore, an Administrative Law Judge's ruling on party status is not a significant issue of policy or law to merit intervention by the Commission. The District's request to certify this issue is an attempt to get around the prohibition of interlocutory appeals. Allowing requests for certified questions to be used in this manner would set a bad precedent for other cases when a party receives an unfavorable ruling on party status.
