- A. General location map delineating the proposed service area with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed service area within the county.

- metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state land surveyor 1. or a registered professional land surveyor; or
- projectable digital data with metadata (proposed areas should be in 2. a single record and clearly labeled for each utility), or
- following verifiable natural and man-made landmarks; or 3.
- copies of recorded plat map with metes and bounds. 4.
- C. Written descriptions of the proposed service area.
- 2. Please indicate if Bi County WSC will need to obtain approval letters from lenders to release a portion of their service area.

These items must be completed and returned to our office by July 19, 2010. If we do not receive the requested information by this date, your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.
