A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT

This Professional Service Contract ("Contract") is entered into as of the 6th day of July 2006 by and between **South Central Water Company / Sugar Tree on the Brazos** ("the Utility"), and **ECO Resources, Inc.** a Texas Corporation ("ECO")

RECITALS

The Utility owns and operates or will own and operate a wastewater utility system consisting of a collection system, receiving and transporting domestic wastewaters, and a wastewater treatment plant receiving the collected wastewater and providing treatment as required to discharge an effluent that meets all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.

The Utility assures that all such facilities are or will be built in accordance with all applicable local, state and federal regulations and that the facilities are or will be in good working order, do not or will not contain any known defective equipment and are suitable or will be suitable and adequate for the reasonable needs of its present and expected future customers.

This Contract provides for ECO to furnish to the Utility certain services necessary for the proper maintenance and operation of the wastewater systems and to receive compensation from the Utility for those services rendered in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

Now therefore, for and in consideration of the above referenced Recitals, all of which are true and correct, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties enter into the following Agreement whereby the Wastewater Utility System of the Utility will be operated, maintained and managed by ECO

ARTICLES

1. SERVICES

Section 1.01. Certified Personnel. ECO represents that all of the Utility's facilities shall be operated only under the direct supervision of personnel who possess valid Certificates of Competency as required by the State of Texas and shall maintain continuing education competency certifications consistent with requirements of the State of Texas

Section 1.02. Routine Maintenance. ECO shall perform routine maintenance on the Utility's equipment at the Utility's facilities as required by the Discharge Permit, all laws, rules, and regulations of all governmental entities having or claiming jurisdiction and consistent with good operating and maintenance practices. Examples of such maintenance include, but are not limited to: lubrication of equipment, cleaning and replacing filters, replacement of facility control lamps, adjustment or replacement of pump packing, and other routine maintenance specified by the respective equipment manufacturers. ECO shall effectively utilize its personnel, tools, and equipment to the benefit of the Utility, and maintain permanent records of the maintenance performed on the Utility's facilities and equipment. Maintenance, as described in this section, shall not include costs associated with flood, fire, acts of God or other similar extraordinary occurrences.

Section 1.03. Emergency Repairs. ECO shall promptly respond to any emergency throughout the year regardless of the day or the time of day. In all cases where, in the opinion of ECO, the estimated costs will exceed the dollar amount specified as "authorized maintenance level" (Exhibit 'A'), every reasonable attempt will be made to contact the Utility's representative and notify him of the particular situation. The fact that said notification cannot be made shall not limit ECO to the dollar expenditure that is required to correct the emergency. Emergencies are defined as but are not limited to:

1. A hazardous condition
2. A condition resulting in degradation of the wastewater treatment plant's effluent to maximum contaminant levels in excess of limits allowed by the Utility's wastewater discharge permits
3. A condition which, in the opinion of ECO or any other representative of the Utility, poses an immediate threat to develop into one of the two emergencies listed above.

Labor and equipment costs associated with emergency repairs will be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility in accordance with Exhibit 'B'.

Section 1.04. Non-Emergency Repairs. ECO shall, during its regular workday, perform repairs not required in Section 1.03 above. ECO shall schedule such non-emergency repairs on a first-call, first-serve basis, unless specifically asked to accelerate its response to a particular item by an authorized Utility representative or unless, under the circumstances, such non-emergency repair should be completed more promptly in order to avoid any violations of the Discharge Permit or any applicable laws, rules or regulations or damage to the Plant or any part thereof. ECO shall receive approval from said Utility representative prior to performing non-emergency repairs when, in ECO's opinion, the estimated cost of said repair will exceed the dollar amount specified as "authorized

maintenance level" (Exhibit 'A'). Within forty-eight (48) hours of notification, the Utility shall provide ECO with written confirmation of said approval. Actual labor and equipment costs associated with non-emergency repairs will be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility in accordance with Exhibit 'B'.

Section 1.05. Sub-Contract Repairs. ECO may sub-contract repairs and/or services. However, such sub-contracting shall not relieve ECO of any of its obligations under this Contract, and sub-contractors shall be considered employees of ECO for the purposes of delineating those responsibilities. ECO shall supervise and inspect all sub-contracted repairs or services performed under the terms of this Contract. Actual cost associated with sub-contracted repairs will be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility, including supervision and inspection fees as contained in Exhibit 'A'.

Section 1.06. Materials. All materials used by ECO in providing services under this Contract shall be billed to the Utility at actual cost plus an administrative fee as contained in Exhibit 'A'.

Section 1.07. Personnel and Equipment. Fees charged by ECO to the Utility for personnel and equipment used in performing maintenance, where applicable under the terms of this Contract, shall be in accordance with ECO's current Rates for Personnel and Equipment as contained in Exhibit 'B' attached hereto.

Section 1.08. Laboratory Testing. ECO shall perform or have performed sampling and laboratory analysis necessary to insure an acceptable discharge from the Utility's wastewater treatment facility. Additionally, ECO will perform all other tests, including but not limited to, those requested by the Utility, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, the Environmental Protection Agency, or any other governmental

agency with jurisdiction over the Utility's facilities. The Utility will reimburse ECO for all actual cost associated with these sampling and/or laboratory analysis.

Section 1.09. 24-Hour Control Center. ECO shall maintain a 24-hour Control Center. The telephone number of the Control Center shall be clearly displayed on signs posted at each facility site. The Control Center shall maintain continuous communications interface with ECO staff and field personnel.

Section 1.10. Telemetric Monitoring. ECO shall, from its Control Center described in Section 1.09 and at the Utility's request, monitor telemetric signal devices installed at any of the Utility's facilities. Installation of such devices shall be at the Utility's discretion and the Utility shall reimburse ECO for the purchase and installation of such equipment, and monthly costs for telephone lines.

Section 1.11. Chemical Inventories. ECO shall purchase and maintain an inventory of chemicals routinely used in the operation of the Utility's facilities. Chemical inventories shall be stored at the respective facility sites in quantities sufficient to assure continuous operation of each facility. The cost of all such chemicals purchased on behalf of the Utility shall be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility.

Section 1.12. Grounds Keeping and Mowing. ECO will be responsible for as needed grounds keeping and mowing inside the fences of the Utility's facilities. The cost of this service shall be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility.

Section 1.13. Sludge Management. ECO shall arrange for the removal and the proper disposal of sewage sludge from the Utility's facilities. The cost of this service shall be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility.

Section 1.14. Expendable Items. ECO shall provide the expendable items used in the operation of the Utility's facilities. Such items include, but are not limited to, brooms, mops, trash receptacles, trash bags, shovels, rakes, hoses, nozzles, dip nets and padlocks. Costs of these items are to ECO's account and included as part of the base Contract price.

Section 1.15. Meetings. Representatives of ECO shall attend scheduled meetings of the Utility.

Section 1.16. Correspondence and Inquiries. ECO shall respond to all correspondence and/or inquiries from the Utility's owner(s) or designated representative(s) in a prompt and professional manner.

Section 1.17. Customer Relations. ECO shall render to the Utility any and all reasonable assistance in the promotion of good relations with the Utility's customers.

2. INSPECTIONS.

Section 2.01. Facility/ies. ECO shall inspect the Utility's facility/ies five (5) days per week to conform to regulatory requirements, and maintain a written inspection log of each inspection as part of the Utility's records.

Section 2.02. Other Inspections. ECO shall perform such other inspections as the Utility may request or which ECO believes are necessary to protect the integrity of the Utility System and/or the health and safety of the general public. The cost of these inspections will be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility. ECO shall inspect the customer's hookup into the collection system under the Base Operations Fee when inspections are performed during ECO's routine facility inspections as referenced in Section 2.01. Any inspections requested to be performed at any time other than during ECO's routine facility inspections as referenced in Section 2.01 must be approved by the Utility and will be billed

to the Utility on a time and material basis utilizing ECO's labor and equipment rates in accordance with Exhibit "B".

3. REPORTS

All costs for compiling, preparing, and submitting the below listed reports are to ECO's account and included as part of the base Contract price.

Section 3.01. Operations Report. ECO shall submit to the Utility a monthly operations report including, but not limited to, the following information:

1. Summary of maintenance and repair back-charges
2. Insurance claims filed or pending disposition
3. Current cash receipts from customer billings
4. Current billings to customers
5. Current accounts receivable from customer billings
6. Summary of maintenance and repair by facility classification
7. Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") and EPA self-monitoring reports and responses to any inquiries from the TNRCC, EPA and any other governmental agencies relating to the Utility System with a copy to be sent to the Utility
8. Copies of all reports and correspondence made by ECO to local, state or federal regulatory agencies on behalf of the Utility

A clear audit trail of all ECO transactions on behalf of the Utility shall be maintained by ECO. Records of such transactions shall be available to the Utility's Auditor during normal working hours and ECO shall provide fullest cooperation and adequate working space for the conduct of audits.

Section 3.02. Compliance Reports. As part of the base fee, ECO shall promptly prepare and submit all operational and compliance reports required by the Texas

Commission on Environmental Quality, the EPA, or any other local, state or federal agency with a copy being sent to the Utility.

4. INSURANCE

Section 4.01. Insurance. Following execution of this agreement ECO will have its insurance carrier/s issue directly to the Utility each year certificates of insurance for the following insurance coverage:

Section 4.02. Maintenance of Insurance. ECO affirms that the above referenced insurance will be maintained in force throughout the term of this Contract.

5. GUARANTIES, INDEMNITY, AND HOLD HARMLESS

Section 5.01. Guaranties. ECO shall use generally accepted business practices to procure materials and replacement equipment. ECO shall not be responsible to the Utility for any guaranty or guaranties in connection with such materials or replacement equipment. ECO shall use reasonable efforts to obtain the normal guaranties applicable in the particular industry manufacturing such materials or replacement equipment, and shall assign same to the Utility.

Section 5.02. Indemnify and Hold Harmless. Except as otherwise set forth in

this Contract, ECO hereby agrees to, and shall hold harmless the Utility from any claim, for (including loss of plant use) arising out of the (the facilities sludge, effluent, water, sewage (undeveloped), roadways, walkways, the atmosphere, water. ECO shall not be liable to the Utility to hold harmless ECO, its officers, agents and employees from damage, injury or expense, including attorney's fees, other than intentional, willful or sole negligent dispersal, release, or escape of the facilities' effluents into or upon land, the atmosphere, or any water. Liability for consequential or incidental damage shall be harmless of ECO by the Utility shall apply whether under contract, tort (including active or passive

6. PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR INFLATION

From commencement of this Contract, until the price shall be increased or decreased according to the annual Consumer Price Index - All Urban Consumers - United States, 1982=100.

Area. This adjustment in service compensation shall be calculated using the following formula:

Adjustments to compensation for changes in the Consumer Price Index shall be cumulative.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

Section 7.01. Record Drawings. The Utility has provided ECO with all record drawings in its possession of its entire utility system. ECO shall maintain these drawings in a manner which allows their efficient and effective use in solving system problems. Upon termination of this Contract ECO will, within thirty (30) days from the date of termination, return to the Utility all drawings, plots and data relating to the system.

Section 7.02. Identification. Employees of ECO shall readily identify themselves when communicating within the Utility and with Utility customers. Maintenance and Operating personnel shall possess pictured I.D. cards, wear distinctive clothing bearing the ECO name, and their vehicles shall also display the ECO name. All other ECO employees shall possess pictured I.D. cards.

Section 7.03. Modification. Modification of this Contract shall be made only by a written document signed by ECO and the Utility.

Section 7.04. Assignability. This contract shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors in interest to and assigns of the parties. Neither the Utility, nor ECO, however, may voluntarily assign this Contract or any portion thereof, without receiving the prior written consent of the other party. Assignability will not be unreasonably withheld.

Section 7.05. Reasonable Diligence. ECO agrees to use reasonable diligence in the operation of the Utility's facility/ies and utility system.

Section 7.06. Abnormal Conditions. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Contract, in the event the Utility's wastewater treatment plant loading exceeds the Utility's wastewater treatment plant design parameters, or in the event influent contains abnormal toxic or other substances which cannot be removed or treated by the existing Utility's wastewater treatment plant, and which may result in effluent which violates the Utility's waste discharge permit, ECO will use its best efforts to maximize plant performance, but shall not be responsible for associated effluent characteristics or damages, fines, penalties or claims resulting therefrom. ECO shall advise the Utility of the abnormal situation and planned course of corrective action within forty-eight (48) hours of occurrence. ECO agrees to return the Utility's wastewater treatment plant effluent to permit limits within twenty (20) calendar days after the influent returns to acceptable limits.

Section 7.07. Force Majeure. Neither party shall not be deemed to be in default if performance of the obligations required by this Contract is delayed, disrupted, or becomes impossible because of any act of God, war, earthquake, fire, flood, strike, accident, civil commotion, epidemic, act of government, its agencies or officers, or any other cause beyond the control of the parties ("Force Majeure"). Upon occurrence of any such event, ECO

shall operate the Utility's facility/ies and utility system on a "best reasonable effort" basis and shall not be responsible for damages, fines, penalties or claims resulting therefrom. If any additional expense is incurred by ECO in such operation, that expense shall be deemed to be an "Extraordinary Cost" and those costs will be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility.

Section 7.08. Fines and Penalties/Wastewater Treatment Plant. While this Contract is in force, and so long as the Utility's wastewater treatment facility/ies meets the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's design criteria for its wastewater loading, and, as long as the Utility has not specifically rejected ECO's operational recommendations which would have prevented unauthorized discharge of effluents, or effluents of a quality which violate the Utility's wastewater discharge permits, ECO will pay any and all fines or penalties against the Utility as a result of actions taken by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or the Environmental Protection Agency and any and all governmental entities having or claiming to have jurisdiction. ECO will not be responsible for any fines or penalties that are a result of actions taken against the Utility prior to the Contract date.

Section 7.09. Compliance with Applicable Laws. ECO agrees to operate the Utility System in compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules and regulations.

Section 7.10. Independent Contractor. ECO is not an employee of the Utility, but serves the Utility as an independent contractor.

Section 7.11. Notice. Such notice as required under this Contract shall be in writing and shall be sent by certified mail, facsimile, or personal delivery to the intended party's

address of record. Notice shall be deemed to have been given when the notice was first mailed to the following addresses of record:

8. PAYMENTS AND NON-COMPENSABLE ITEMS

Section 8.01. Payments. The Utility shall compensate ECO for services rendered under the terms of this Contract and as contained in Exhibits 'A' and 'B'. The Utility agrees to pay interest, at a rate of 12% per annum, to ECO for all undisputed invoiced amounts unpaid after 30 days of the date of invoice. Interest shall accrue from the 31st day following date of invoice until the date payment is received by ECO.

Section 8.02. Non-Compensable Items. Compensation paid to ECO is exclusive of any tax, assessment, regulatory expense or other charge which may be imposed by any governmental authority upon ECO in the course of performing its obligations pursuant to this Contract other than the taxes upon the purchase of materials, utilities, parts or supplies. In the event that ECO is required by law or applicable regulation to pay or collect any such tax, assessment, regulatory expense or other charge in the course of performing its obligations pursuant to this Contract, the amount paid or collected shall be reimbursed to ECO by the Utility in addition to other compensation paid by the Utility to ECO under the

terms and conditions set forth herein. ECO affirms that it shall pay corporate income and franchise taxes arising out of its operations, taxes or contributions imposed by law, regulation or trade union contract measured by, the compensation paid to employees of ECO or its subsidiaries, but not limited to, taxes or contributions for unemployment compensation, retirement benefits, welfare funds, pensions, annuities and disability benefits. ECO shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Utility from any liability for taxes or contributions, or the interest or penalties for failure to pay.

9. TERM

Section 9.01. Term. This Contract shall remain in effect following execution and shall automatically renew for one (1) year, subject to the right of either party to terminate this Contract with written notice of such termination to the other party sixty (60) calendar days prior to cancellation date.

Section 9.02. Termination for Cause. Either party may terminate this Contract for material breach by the other party, or for failure to perform to the standards set forth by the Contract, providing that the terminating party first provides written notice of breach or failure to perform to the other party and the breach or failure is not corrected within sixty (60) calendar days of the notice. If the defaulting party is diligently pursuing the cure of such sixty (60) day period is diligently pursuing the cure of such default, and it is likely that such default can be cured by the continued diligent efforts of the defaulting party, the non-defaulting party shall grant the defaulting party such assistance as is reasonably necessary to complete the cure. 
10. OWNERSHIP OF WASTEWATER AND SLUDGE







COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES

- I. BASE OPERATIONS FEE:** For and in consideration of the services rendered to and on behalf of the Utility by ECO, the Utility shall pay to ECO according to the following schedule each month:
- The sum of \$1,000.00 per month, plus \$3.50 per connection to the Wastewater Utility System.
- II. AUTHORIZED MAINTENANCE LEVEL:** Consistent with cost containment, efficient maintenance and maximum protection of the Utility, the Utility authorizes ECO to perform non-emergency repairs. The cost of such repairs will not exceed \$1,000.00.
- III. MATERIALS:** Materials billed to the Utility shall be at a discount rate of 15%.
- IV. SUB-CONTRACT(S):** Supervision and inspection fees shall be 15% of the dollar amount of the sub-contract.
- V. EXTRAORDINARY SERVICES:** ECO anticipates that it will not be required to perform services not specified in this Contract upon receipt of prior approval from the Utility. Services not anticipated and not specified in this Contract shall be negotiated between the Utility and ECO. The Utility and ECO agree to negotiate the cost of such services in good faith. Additionally, if at any time during the term of this Contract, tornadoes, floods or other natural disaster shall occur causing extraordinary expenditures by ECO, ECO shall bill the Utility for such expenditures to the Utility. The Utility shall pay such bill within thirty (30) days of receipt, provided it is reasonable and necessary, within thirty (30) days of receipt.
- VI. GENERAL PROVISION FOR ADJUSTMENT:** If an increase in the cost of labor or materials for the Utility should occur, including, but not limited to, changes in regulations, reporting requirements and product water contract operations, then ECO shall be entitled to adjust its compensation to the Utility. Such additional compensation will be negotiated between the Utility and ECO within thirty (30) days of receiving such request from ECO.

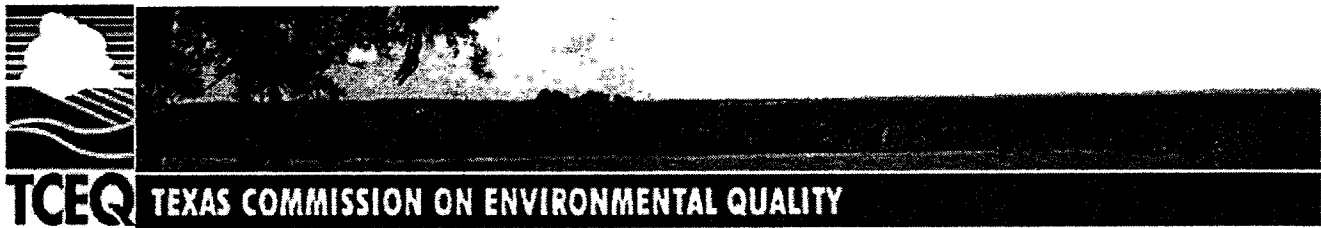

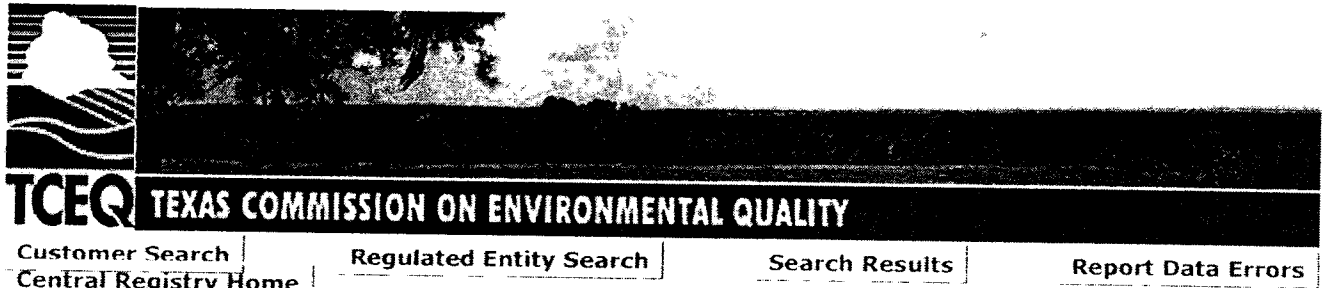
