South Central Water Company, Mr. Malcolm Bailey, principal, applies for amendment to the sewer CCN to provide sewer service to a new stand-alone area of about 1,500 acres. There is no indication of current customers, requests for service, or the identity of the developer. The tariff requires the developer to be responsible for contribution in aid of construction, but as indicated below, Mr. Bailey continues to provide personal financial information indicating he has adequate reserve.

I have requested current financial information and received a personal balance sheet for Malcolm D. Bailey dated April 30, 2006, which is attached to the original of this memorandum. Mr. Bailey continues to show substantial liquidity with total assets of \$21 mil., total liabilities of \$3.7 mil. and equity of \$17.3 mil., for a debt to equity ratio of .21:1. The projected profit and loss statement for the development shows positive cash flow over \$8,000 in the third year, once again. Mr. Bailey's balance sheet shows marketable securities of \$6.4 mil. and cash of \$22,757 so he should be able to fund the cash flow loss in the first years.

In my opinion, this applicant continues to demonstrate adequate financial and managerial capability to provide service to the requested areas. These conclusions are based on information provided by the applicant prior to this date and may not reflect any changes in the applicant's status subsequent to this date.






