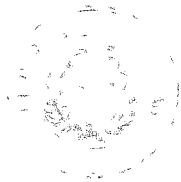

2. The maps submitted do not meet the mapping requirements. Please submit four (4) copies of the following map information:
 - a. General location map delineating the proposed service area with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed service area within the county.
 - b. Maps showing **only** the proposed service area by:
 - (1) Metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state land surveyor or a registered professional land surveyor; or
 - (2) projectable digital data with metadata (proposed areas should be in a single record and clearly labeled for each utility), or
 - (3) following verifiable natural and man-made landmarks; or


- (4) copies of recorded plat map with metes and bounds.
3. Written description of the proposed service area.
 4. In addition to the maps mentioned in item 2., please provide four (4) copies of a map showing existing facilities in the proposed service areas, illustrating separately:
 - facilities for production
 - facilities for transmission
 - facilities for distribution
 5. Complete and submit four (4) copies of the proposed sewer utility tariff. For your convenience, I have enclosed a copy of the sewer utility tariff form.
 6. Provide four (4) copies of the response to deficiencies listed in the inspection report letter, listing the actions taken or being taken to correct the listed deficiencies, including the proposed completion dates.

What is this?

These items must be completed and returned to our office by **July 19, 2010**. If we do not receive the requested information by this date, your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.
