

- Non Standard Service Agreement is the agreement between the Utility and the Developer b A. 14 provide service to his property. The significance of this agreement is that the Developer may 15 be required to provide contributions in aid of construction in amount sufficient to reimburse 16 the utility for existing uncommitted facilities at their original cost if the utility has not 17 previously been reimbursed. A utility shall not be reimbursed for facilities in excess of the 18 amount the utility paid for the facilities. A utility is not required to allocate existing 19 uncommitted facilities to a developer for projected development beyond a reasonable 20 planning period; or additional facilities compliant with the Commission's minimum design 21 criteria for facilities used in the production, transmission, pumping, or treatment of water or 22 the Commission's minimum design criteria for wastewater collection and treatment facilities 23 and to provide for reasonable local demand requirements. Income tax liabilities which may 24 be incurred due to collection of contributions in aid of construction may be included in 25 extension charges to developers. Additional tax liabilities due to collection of the original tax 26 liability may not be collected unless they can be supported and are specifically noted in the 27 approved extension policy. 28

#### 1 Q. In your opinion, is it feasible to obtain water and sewer services from an adjacent retail 2 public utility?

A. The City of Boerne is the only utility that is adjacent to the proposed area. The notice of the application was provided to the City of Boerne. The City of Boerne initially protested these applications but later withdrew its protest and request for public hearing. However, the City of Boerne did not show any intention to provide the service in the proposed area.

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### Q. In your opinion, will the environmental integrity be affected by the granting of these CCN amendments?

9 Without any specific development plans, the effect on environmental integrity cannot be 10 determined. However, it can be stated that the environmental integrity will be temporarily 11 disturbed due to the construction of water distribution lines, sewage collection lines and the 12 construction of additional pumping and storage facilities, treatment facilities by whomever 13 provide service to the area. However, a properly constructed and operated central sewer 14 collection system is better than individual on-site sewage facilities.

### Q. In your opinion, will granting a water CCN amendment improves service or lower costs to consumers in the area?

A. Regarding the improvement of service, there is no central service being provided in the proposed area. Current customers of the Tapatio Springs Service Company will not be affected by this application. Since the applicant already has a water CCN, its current water rate/tariff will not be changed as a result of this application and should continue to charge the existing rates to its customers in the proposed area.

### Q. In your opinion, will granting a sewer CCN amendment improves service or lower costs to consumers in the area?

A. Regarding the improvement of service, there is no central service being provided in the proposed area. Current customers of the Tapatio Springs Service Company will not be affected by this application. Since the applicant already has a sewer CCN, its current sewer rate/tariff will not be changed as a result of this application and should continue to charge the existing rates to its customers in the proposed area.


