Dear Chief Docketing Clerk:

Yesterday a notice in the case captioned above was issued for a preliminary hearing on December 3, 2008, in Austin at 10:00 a.m. The TCEQ staff who sent the Notice of Hearing to your office inadvertently listed Austin as the location.

This case is a rate increase application involving a retail public utility providing service in the Houston area. Under Tex. Water Code Sec. 13.187(f), if more than half of the ratepayers of the utility receive service in a county with a population of more than 2.5 million, the hearing must be held at a location in that county. Harris County has a population exceeding 2.5 million, and more than half the ratepayers receive service there. As a result, by law this hearing must be held in Harris County, preferably in Houston. Because of the drive, we also request that the time be noticed for 11:00 a.m., not 10:00 a.m.
