We spoke on Friday about the surcharge Community Utility Company has put on the water charges for my mother.

Her name is: Mae Hasty. I believe the utility company may have her as "M.W. Hasty"

Her address is: 302 Misty Day Crosby, Texas 77532 Her account number with Community is: Rt.20 123

Her latest bill included a CIP surcharge of \$60.00 in addition to her regular monthly water bill which is approximately \$32.00 a month. When I contacted Community Utility about this, I was told that this will be a monthly charge for "improvements going forward."

I'd like to file a complaint about this. This far exceeds what my mother can pay for water service. She is elderly and lives on Social Security.

Per your instructions, I have sent a letter to the utility company protesting the surcharge on my mother's behalf and telling them she will continue to pay the water portion of the bill only until some resolution about this surcharge is reached.

Some further information that may be helpful is the fact that Mom has lived at this address for the past 30 years. There is, and always has been, a water meter on her property. A few years ago, Community increased their fees stating that the money was needed to install water meters on all properties in Heathergate. As far as this family knows, this was never done. We feel that since Mom already has a water meter, she should not have to shoulder the burden of paying for others.







INCREASE TOO LARGE (223 %)

QUALITY OF WATER IS VERY POOR AND MUST BE FILTERED BEFORE USING NO FIRE HYDRANTS

Recently we received a Notice from our Community Utility Company advising of a proposed rate increase. I am writing you to protest this increase due to the lack of and poor service of our utility. Our rate is too low and we should be paying more however, due to problem with the utility I cannot believe that they are to be trusted to make the improvements they state in the proposal. We have many incidences during the year were the water is golden to dark brown. We have to endure regular outages as to there is no backup system to run the pumps when the power is out. Low pressure and clogged house filters due the nasty water is a regular problem. My neighbor reported a leaking line on Enchantment and it took five weeks to get the line repaired. I estimate that we have lost two thousand dollars in clothes due to the brown water invading the washing machine. When I have called to complain about the quality of water and how it has ruined many clothes over the years I have been informed that we only pay \$12.50 so they can't do anything about it. I feel that if they want to raise the rates they should be held to timelines of improvement for services first. I regularly receive the quality reports but I'm sure that the samples are drawn on good days only and without supervision. As to meter readings I do not believe that a meter in our subdivision has been read in years and I highly doubt that they will clear the way to replace the meters. If you allow an increase please base it solely on providing improved services for the public health and safety. If requested I would gladly come to Austin to provide samples of the water we have coming out of our tap. I would then challenge any member of the panel to drink the water. I know that you would not. If requested I can send pictures, incase you really don't want to see how bad this water can be in person.

Finally, as stated our rates are low and should be increased but please do not allow an increase of rates without quality accountability and timelines to force the improvements.

My husband and I have been in residence at 23319 Fantasia Huffman Texas since 1994, and the only improvement seen in that time has been in unreliability. The water quality continues to have problems with mineral contamination (red discoloration) on a periodic basis. This has led to the loss of clothes due to staining from this mineral problem. Filters down to 1 micron have been installed, but the problem persists. The water is untreated and though it meets the water quality standards (?) a black algae forms on shower heads and bath faucets.

The proposed rate increase of 450% seems excessive, for no improvement in service. Other communities in the area have rates that are lower than those proposed by Community Utility Company and they provide **TREATED WATER AND SEWER SERVICE.** Community Utility Company **ONLY** provides water service.

I can not believe they have been providing water for all these years at a loss and should have had small increases over the last 19 years if additional income was needed. On the other hand, if they plan to use the increase to provide better water where expensive household filters are not required, I could somewhat agree to this proposed rate change. I can't believe we will get anything but what we have in the past and trust that you will reduce this increase to something far less that the proposed amount.



This letter is being sent in protest of the proposed rate increase by Community Utility Company CCN #10350, the rate increase is exorbitant and unjustified. My wife and I have been in residence at 23306 Fantasia Huffman Texas since 1974, the only improvement seen in that time has been in reliability. The water quality continues to have problems with mineral contamination (red discoloration) on a periodic basis. This has led to the loss of clothes due to staining from this mineral problem. Filters down to 1 micron have been installed, but the problem persists. The water is untreated and though it meets the water quality standards (?) a black algae forms on shower heads and bath faucets.

The proposed rate increase of 450% seems excessive, for no improvement in service. Other communities in the area have rates that are lower than those proposed by Community Utility Company and they provide TREATED WATER AND SEWER SERVICE. Community Utility Company ONLY provides water service.



This letter is written in protest to the proposed rate increase submitted by the above named company. While an increase in our water bill is understandable, a 400% plus increase is not, especially without knowing what improvements and modifications, if any, are being planned for our neighborhoods.

Currently when there is a power outage there is no backup power provided which leaves our neighborhood without water, sometimes for days. Brown water is also a problem at different times during the year. While this has improved somewhat it still exists. We have to have not only a water softener but we have 2 water filters on our water lines in an effort to clear up the water. However, this does not completely eliminate the problem. There are times when we fill the bath tub, flush the toilet or wash cloths and the water is brown. This is due in part to a high iron content which is a problem with shallow water supplies.

We do receive their yearly water analysis which shows the water tested within the required ranges, but that doesn't change the fact that it's a shallow well and everyone around us on this same service experiences problems with brown water.

We not only own our home but also several rental properties in our neighborhood and this would have a great impact on us. Until we are provided with more information from Community Utility regarding their plans we can not accept their proposal for an increase.
