



CITY OF AUSTIN'S STATUS UPDATE ON ITS COMMENTS, CONCERNS AND RESPONSES TO PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO THE CITY OF AUSTIN

TO: Commission Staff, by and through their counsel of record, Jessica A. Gray and Thomas L. Tynes, Public Utility Commission of Texas, 1701 N. Congress Avenue, PO Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711.

COMES NOW, the City of Austin, (herein sometimes referred to as "City," "Austin" or "Respondent"), in the above styled and docketed wholesale water rate appeal proceeding and serves this, its Status Update on its General and Specific Comments, Concerns and Responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information to the City of Austin, on all parties to this Proceeding.

Counsel for the City of Austin has spoken to Counsel for the Commission Staff. Counsel for the City of Austin has agreed to provide responses on an ongoing basis to the Public Utility Commission Staff's First Request for Information to the City of Austin, Staff 1-1 through Staff 1-31, subject to general and specific comments, concerns and the right to amend or supplement. Austin noted to Commission Staff counsel that a continuance of the Prehearing Conference was agreed to by all parties with the Commission Staff's knowledge that Austin counsel and Austin Water Utility staff were in another rate case during the time previously scheduled for the Prehearing Conference, and could not reasonably be called upon to prepare discovery responses during that time period. At the same time, many of the Commission Staff requested items are subject to further definition by the Administrative Law Judges, not limited solely to a ruling on Austin's Motion to Dismiss. Moreover, Commission Staff has requested such a breadth of information that thousands of pages of discovery are at issue, even before Petitioners and Respondent have the opportunity to determine or resolve any matters in dispute—even if Commission Staff could review and make use of the information Austin provides and form its own opinions regarding the issues in this case based on the information it receives before the Prehearing Conference. At the same time, all parties need time to prepare for the Preliminary Hearing scheduled for March 23, 2015.

Accordingly, counsel for Austin is working to provide responses to the following Commission Staff Requests for Information, and expects to file those either later today or first thing tomorrow morning, following the PUC Procedural Rules and the Commission Staff instructions:

Staff 1-1; Staff 1-2; Staff 1-3; Staff 1-4; Staff 1-5; Staff 1-6; Staff 1-7; Staff 1-8; Staff 1-9; Staff 1-10; Staff 1-13; Staff 1-17; Staff 1-19; Staff 1-28; and Staff 1-29.

Austin provides this status update in response to a request from Commission Staff counsel.
