CITY OF AUSTIN'S APPEAL OF SOAH ORDER NO. 7

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS:

COMES NOW, the City of Austin, (herein sometimes referred to as "City," "Austin", "Austin Water Utility" or "Respondent"), in the above styled and docketed water and wastewater rate appeal proceeding, and pursuant to P.U.C. Proc. R. §22.123 serves this, its Appeal of SOAH Order No. 7 issued by the Administrative Law Judges ("ALJs") on May 26, 2015. In support thereof, Austin would respectfully show the Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") as follows.

I. INTRODUCTION

Austin seeks appeal of SOAH Order No. 7, Denying Motion for Reconsideration; Adopting Procedural Schedule; and Notice of Hearing. Austin appeals SOAH Order No. 7 under PUC Proc. R. §22.123(a)(2) which authorizes the appeal of written orders of a presiding officer in a contested case hearing.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. On December 22, 2014, Petitioners (the Ratepayers of the Former River Place Water and Wastewater Systems, sometimes referred to as the "former River Place ratepayers") filed the Original Petition Appealing Retail Water and Wastewater Rates of the City of Austin ("Original Petition").
- 2. On March 23, 2015 the ALJs convened the first Prehearing Conference in the above styled and docketed water and wastewater rate appeal to consider jurisdictional matters.
- 3. On May 4, 2015, the ALJs convened a second Prehearing Conference to consider jurisdictional matters, interim rates, and other matters. In that Prehearing Conference, the ALJs announced

- their ruling on the PUC's jurisdiction to consider Petitioners' appeal of Austin's October 1, 2014 and November 1, 2014 increases in water and wastewater rates to the former ratepayers of the River Place Water and Wastewater Systems; and Petitioners' request for interim rates.
- 4. On May 18, 2015, Austin filed its Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6 and Motion for Reconsideration.
- 5. On May 21, 2015, Commission Staff filed its Response to the City of Austin's Motion for Reconsideration.
- 6. On May 22, 2015, Austin filed its Reply to Commission Staff's Response to the City of Austin's Motion for Reconsideration.
- 7. On May 26, 2015, Commission Staff filed its Response to the City of Austin's Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6; and Petitioners filed their Response to the City of Austin's Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6 and Motion for Reconsideration.
- 8. On May 26, 2015, the ALJs issued SOAH Order No. 7, Denying [Austin's] Motion for Reconsideration; Adopting Procedural Schedule; and Notice of Hearing.
- 9. On June 4, 2015, Austin filed City of Austin's Motion for Reconsideration of the Commission's Denial of the City of Austin's Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6 (referred to herein as "Austin's Motion for Reconsideration"). In Austin's Motion for Reconsideration, Austin asked the Commission to reconsider its denial of Austin's Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6, because the jurisdictional issues were not resolved properly by the ALJs.
- 10. Today, June 5, 2015, Austin files its *City of Austin's Response to Petitioners' Motion for Partial Summary Decision*, asking that Petitioners motion be denied for numerous reasons, including the lack of jurisdiction by the Commission and SOAH.

Below, Austin reasserts the bases for its conclusion that the Original Petition does not satisfy the jurisdictional requirements of Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c), because contrary to the ALJs' analysis in Order No. 6, the Petitioners, River Place Municipal Utility District ("MUD") residents, are not a distinct customer class, so that the signatures of 10% of the residents of River Place MUD are not sufficient. Texas Water Code, §13.043(c) states:

(c) An appeal under Subsection (b) must be initiated by filing a petition for review with the utility commission and the entity providing service within 90 days after the effective day of the rate change or, if appealing under Subdivision (b)(2) or (5), within 90 days after the date on which the governing body of the

municipality or affected county makes a final decision. The petition must be signed by the lesser of 10,000 or 10 percent of those ratepayers whose rates have been changed and who are eligible to appeal under Subsection (b).

[Emphasis supplied.]

Contrary to the ALJs' conclusions, both Austin and Petitioners have submitted evidence and admitted that the rates Austin charges Petitioners are its retail residential water and wastewater rates, such that additional signatures of outside city customers are required in order for Petitioners to meet the requirements of a valid petition under Tex. Water Code, 13.043(c). The ALJs are not empowered to ignore the facts in favor of asserting jurisdiction where the statutory requirements are not met.

III. SOAH ORDER NO. 7 BASED ON FACTUAL ERROR

Austin has previously stated that it generally concurs with the decisions of the ALJs regarding the determination of jurisdiction in this case and Petitioners' request for interim rates in SOAH Order No. 6. However, Austin does not concur with the ALJs' decision as to Petitioners' compliance with Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c) regarding the November 1, 2014 rates. Specifically, the ALJs found:

"... A comparison of the September 26, 2014 notice (provided to the City's environ customers who had not been served by the District) indicates that the City is charging former District customers different rates from the other environ customers. The two notices of the rates are attached to this Order. It appears, based on the documents provided by the City, that Petitioners are being charged different rates from other City environ customers. For this reason, the November 1, 2014 rate change is unique to them. Thus, more than 10% of the former District customers have petitioned for review of the unique set of rates they have been charged since November 1, 2014, the petition meets the requirements of Water Code § 13.043(c), and the Commission has jurisdiction to review these rates pursuant to Water Code §13.043(b).

The ALJs' clearly stated basis for their decision regarding Austin's increase in residential retail rates effective November 1, 2014 was actually a factual error¹. The error was the result of Austin Water Utility staff's inadvertent mistake in a small portion of the rate schedule attached to the September 8, 2014 notice to the new ratepayers of the former River Place Water and Wastewater Systems. The September 8, 2014 notice letter to the new River Place customers included attached water and wastewater rate schedules that contained errors. Specifically, the monthly meter charges in the top far right hand column of Attachment 1 to Exhibit B, Bates Stamp COA 0031, as attached to SOAH Order No. 6 showed the Non-Residential Commercial rates for all but the 5/8" meter charge, which is stated correctly. [See the affidavit of David A. Anders, which is attached to this pleading as Exhibit "A," and the affidavit of Greg Meszaros, Director, Austin Water Utility, which is attached to this pleading as Exhibit "B."]

In SOAH Order No. 6, the ALJs made the legal determination that jurisdictional requirements were satisfied because Austin included the River Place customers in a different class because it (apparently) intended to charge the new River Place customers different and higher residential water rates than other residential customers who reside outside of Austin's city limits, as reflected in the different fixed monthly minimum meter charges for all but the 5/8" meter. It was on that factual basis—that the River Place ratepayers were a distinct class of ratepayers—that the ALJs concluded that the 360 signatures attached to Petitioners' appeal satisfied the requirement in Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c). Although Petitioners' Original Petition initiating the appeal was signed by 10% of River Place's 1,047 water customers and 1,035 wastewater customers; it was not signed by "10 percent of those ratepayers whose rates have been changed and who are eligible to appeal under Subsection (b)." River Place

¹ In fact, other parties to this appeal did not assert jurisdiction based on this this factual error. Austin corrected this error following the ALJs' explanation of their reasoning in SOAH Order No. 6, and Petitioners' Motion for Partial Summary Decision, filed on April 14, 2015, well before Order No. 6 both contain the correct rates and show that Petitioners are being charged City of Austin residential retail rates no different from other outside City of Austin customers with appeal rights.

residents are included in the same residential retail class eligible to appeal under Subsection (b) as other outside city of Austin, "environs," customers. The undisputed total number of city retail customers who reside outside the corporate limits of Austin who are eligible to appeal (including the customers acquired form the River Place Municipal Utility District) is as follows:

Water ratepayers: 11,240 (10% would require at least 1,240 signatures); and

Wastewater ratepayers: 5,109 (10% would require at least 511 signatures).

Although the erroneous entries in an attachment to Austin's September 8, 2014 notice letter to River Place residents made it appear to the ALJs that the former River Place system ratepayers are a distinct class of environs customers, in fact, they are not.

The former River Place ratepayers are not only charged exactly the same rates as the other 11,240 water and 5,109 wastewater environs customers; they are charged exactly the same water and wastewater rates as *all* Austin Water Utility retail residential customers, including those inside Austin's city limits. [See Affidavit of Greg Meszaros, with attachments, attached as Exhibit B] Austin hereby offers Exhibits A and B attached to this pleading as evidence in this case. Therefore, Petitioners' 360 signatures constitute far less than 10% of 11,240 Austin environs customers, which is required to satisfy Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c).

The ALJs have issued Order No. 7, Denying Motion for Reconsideration; Adopting Procedural Schedule; and Notice of Hearing, on May 26, 2015 which denies Austin's appropriate and timely request that the ALJs treat Austin's appeal of SOAH Order No. 6 as a motion for reconsideration of their ruling under P.U.C Proc. R. §22.123 (a)(8). It also establishes the procedural schedule for the rest of the case. In Order No. 7 the ALJs explained their denial of Austin's request that they reconsider their ruling on November 1, 2014 rates with the following statement:

"The request for reconsideration is denied. The City had ample opportunity to provide evidence and argument concerning jurisdiction, and the City's appeal is now pending before the Commission."

Austin would offer a demurrer on the ALJs' characterization of "ample opportunity" because no party plead the facts that the ALJs used to find jurisdiction over the November 1, 2014 rates and the basis for the ALJs' finding regarding the November 1, 2014 rates was only announced at the May 4, 2015 Prehearing Conference. Petitioners did not plead the "facts" that the ALJs found because they are well aware that the water and wastewater rates that they are *actually charged and are paying*. Austin had no notice that it would have to refute the ALJs' mistake; Austin's first opportunity to do so was its appeal of SOAH Order No. 6.

IV. SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION CANNOT VEST IF STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT MET

At this time, through numerous pleadings of Austin and Petitioners, the ALJs and the PUC have been put on notice of a fatal flaw in the jurisdictional facts of this water and wastewater rate appeal. The agency's subject matter jurisdiction over a case is always appropriate to consider, and never untimely in the legal sense, when evidence is offered that challenges the existence of a case's jurisdictional facts. See *Bland Ind. Sch. Dist.* v. *Blue*, 34 S.W.3d 547, 555 (Tex. 2000). If Petitioners simply do not comprise 10% of the affected group of the ratepayers under Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c) then they have no statutory authority to appeal a rate (November 1, 2014 rates) to the PUC. The timing of this information being brought to the agency's attention is irrelevant to the PUC's jurisdiction to consider the case. At the same time, proceeding with an expensive contested case as if the challenge to crucial jurisdictional facts had not occurred would be unlawful and wasteful to Austin's ratepayers, including Petitioners.

Moreover, Petitioners themselves provided the ALJs with an admission that is relevant to the PUCs jurisdiction over the November 1, 2014 rate change. At p. 9 of their Motion for Partial Summary Decision, Petitioners included the following table:

This table in Petitioners' Motion correctly sets out the rates that are charged to River Place residents and all City of Austin environs customers, and corrects the erroneous table that Austin attached to its September 8, 2014 notice to the former River Place ratepayers². In Order No. 6, the ALJs noted what appeared to be higher rates for the former River Place customers than for other environs customers, and concluded that the apparently higher rates charged to the former River Place ratepayers put them in a distinct class. Under the ALJs' analysis and ruling, the 360 signatures of the River Place residents on the Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c) Petition instituting this appeal constituted 10% of the "distinct class." On this basis, the ALJs concluded that Petitioners satisfied the jurisdictional requirement of Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c).

Austin appealed this ruling in SOAH Order No. 6 and has filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission's denial of consideration of its appeal. Austin notes that the referenced table of rates in Petitioners' Motion for Summary Disposition does not agree with the River Place rates as attached to SOAH Order No. 6, which the ALJs asserted provided the jurisdictional basis for this appeal in Order

² In this case, Petitioners calculate "Base" rates, which are a combination of the fixed meter charges and the monthly tiered minimum charge. Similarly, the Volumetric Charges are a combination of the Volume Unit Charges and the \$0.19 Water Revenue Stability Reserve Fund. Therefore, although the presentation of the calculations presented is different from Austin's notice, the retail residential water and wastewater rates for River Place Residents are exactly the same as Austin asserted in its Appeal of SOAH Order No. 6, and not as shown in the ALJs' attachment to SOAH Order No. 6.

No. 6.³ In including the chart on Page 9 of Petitioners' Motion for Partial Summary Decision, Petitioners *judicially admit* that the factual basis used by the ALJs (but not asserted by any party) to find jurisdiction over the November 1, 2014 rate change is in error. The ratepayers of the former River Place Systems are not, in fact, actually paying the water and wastewater rates reflected in the rate table attached to Austin's September 8, 2014 notice. Therefore, they are not a part of a class separate from Austin's 11,240 environs customers. The petition which included only some 360 signatures of River Place Residents does not satisfy the requirements of a petition to initiate a rate appeal under Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c).

Austin asserts the ALJs are obligated to consider all the evidence of jurisdictional facts pertinent to the PUC's jurisdiction over the November 1, 2014 retail residential water and wastewater rate changes. It is well settled that a court, in evaluating a plea to the jurisdiction, is not required to look solely to the pleadings but may consider evidence and *must do so* when necessary to resolve the jurisdictional issues raised. [*Bland Ind. Sch. Dist.* v. *Blue*, 34 S.W.3d 547, 554 (Tex. 2000)]⁴. Even more clearly, the Court of Appeals, Fourteenth District, Houston in *Henderson* v. *The City of Houston*, 14-13-01025-CV (Tex. App.—Houston [14th Dist.] March 3, 2015, citing *Texas Dep't of Parks & Wildlife* v. *Miranda*, 133 S.W.3d 217, 227 (Tex. 1993) held:

"When a plea to the jurisdiction challenges the plaintiff's pleadings, the trial court must determine if the plaintiff alleges facts that affirmatively demonstrate the court's jurisdiction [TPWD v. Miranda at 227] When a plea to the jurisdiction

³ As Austin has stated repeatedly:

It is undisputed that the total number of city retail customers who reside outside the corporate limits of Austin who are eligible to appeal (including the customers acquired form the River Place MUD) is: Water ratepayers: 11,240 (10% would require at least 1,240 signatures); and Wastewater ratepayers: 5,109 (10% would require at least 511 signatures).

Consequently, the Petition does not meet the requirement of the signatures of 10,000 or 10 percent of those ratepayers whose rates have been changed and who are eligible to appeal under Subsection [13.043] (b).

⁴ See also City of League City v. Leblanc, 01-14-00720-CV (Tex. App—Houston [1st Dist.] May 7, 2015; White Point Minerals, Inc. v. Swatner, 13-14-00262-CV (Tex. App.—Corpus Christi) May 28, 2015 citing City of Elsa v. Gonzalez, 325 S.W.3d 622, 625 (Tex. 2004).

challenges the existence of jurisdictional facts, the trial court considers relevant evidence submitted by the parties when necessary submitted by the parties when necessary to resolve the jurisdictional issued raised."

Henderson, supra, at p. 4 (Emphasis supplied.)

Austin further asserts that the ALJs and the PUC are without jurisdiction under Tex. Water Code, §13.043(c) to consider Petitioners' December 22, 2014 appeal of Austin's November 1, 2014 rate change. The 360 signatures attached to Petitioners' complaint fail to satisfy the statutory requirements necessary to invoke the PUC's appellate jurisdiction. The Petitioners are not a statutorily cognizable group that has standing to appeal the November 1, 2014 water and wastewater rates or raise any other issue about how such rates were developed or noticed. Austin does not challenge the jurisdiction of the PUC to consider the October 1, 2014 rate change, only.

V. THE ADOPTED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE IS LEGALLY FLAWED AND CANNOT APPLY TO THIS APPEAL

The issuance of SOAH Order No. 7 and the inclusion of a procedural schedule on the basis that Austin's appeal of SOAH Order No. 6 raised jurisdictional issues untimely is troubling. The ALJs stated at prehearing conferences on March 23, 2015 and May 4, 2015 that they anticipated that both Austin and Petitioners would appeal their jurisdictional determinations to the PUC. The parties adopted a procedural schedule to allow for a Commission determination. Then, while Austin's Appeal of Order No. 6 stating the ALJs' jurisdictional determinations was still pending before the Commission, the ALJs issued Order No. 7, both stating that Austin's appeal was somehow untimely, and adopting a procedural schedule. In this case, it is clear that the rates charged Petitioners are pursuant to Article IV. Rates, Charges and Billing of the Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service and Operations Management of Facilities between the City of Austin and River Place Municipal Utility District; and Amendment to

the Agreement for Emergency Water Service dated September 7, 2009⁵. Yet, the adopted procedural schedule does not provide for a determination of the public interest in PUC/SOAH impairment of the obligations of contract.

The decision in *Texas Water Commission v. City of Fort Worth*, 875 S.W.2d 332 (Tex. App.-Austin 1994, writ denied) ("the *Fort Worth* case") speaks to the importance of providing for a public interest determination in cases where rates are set pursuant to written contract, as provided for in P.U.C. Subst. R. 24.131. Specifically, the court in the *Fort Worth* case held:

"The Texas Constitution limits the State's ability to pass laws that impair contractual obligations to instances where the public safety and welfare must be protected. See, Texas State Teachers Ass'n v. State 711 S.W. 2d 421 423-425 (Tex. App. –Austin 1986, writ ref'd n.r.e.)" See, the Fort Worth case, at p. 335.

Certainly, the analysis regarding the public interest determination required to override the prohibition in the Texas Constitution against laws impairing the obligation of contracts applies to all contracts, not just contracts for wholesale water and wastewater service. More importantly, the *Fort Worth* case court held that the provisions in Tex. Water Code, §13.043(j), which support P.U.C. Subst. R. 24.131 save the Commission's inquiry into whether rates are just and reasonable because they require a public interest determination. In this case, no party other than Austin, nor the ALJs have provided for the public interest determination which would override the State's unlawful impairment of the obligations of the *Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service and Operations Management of Facilities between the City of Austin and River Place Municipal Utility District; and Amendment to the Agreement for Emergency Water Service* dated September 7, 2009.

⁵ Petitioners' counsel has alternatively stated that all or portions of the agreement apply, most recently Petitioners admit that at least Section 4.01 of that Agreement applies to them.

VI. RELIEF REQUESTED

CONSIDERING THE FOREGOING, PURSUANT TO P.U.C. PROC. R. §22.123, THE CITY OF AUSTIN RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS that the Public Utility Commission of Texas overturn the rulings of the SOAH Administrative Law Judges and find and conclude that:

- Austin's presentation of jurisdictional evidence was timely and therefore cannot be disregarded by the ALJs;
- 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas and SOAH do not have jurisdiction of the appeal of the City of Austin November 1, 2014 residential retail water and wastewater rate increases based on an Original Petition which does not include signatures of "the lesser of 10,000 or 10 percent of those ratepayers whose rates have been changed and who are eligible to appeal under [Tex. Water Code, §13.043] Subsection (b)";
- 3. The adopted procedural schedule and notice of hearing in SOAH Order No. 7 is legally flawed and cannot apply; and
- 4. The Appeal by the Ratepayers of the Former River Place Water and Wastewater Systems with respect to Austin's November 1, 2014 residential retail water and wastewater rates must be in all things denied and dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.

Austin also requests that the Commission grant Austin such other and further relief to which Austin is justly entitled.

On this day, David A. Anders appeared before me, the undersigned notary public, and after I administered an oath to him, upon his oath, he said:

- 1. My name is David A. Anders, I am more than 21 years of age, and capable of making this Affidavit. The matters contained herein are true and correct and are within my personal knowledge.
 - 2. I am of sound mind and I am fully competent to make this Affidavit.
- I am the Assistant Director, Finance and Business Services of the City of Austin,
 Austin Water Utility.
- 4. As the Assistant Director of Finance and Business Services for Austin Water, I act as the Austin Water Utility Chief Financial Officer and provide financial guidance and direction to the Executive Team and all program areas of the utility. My responsibilities as the Chief Financial Officer also include overseeing all matters related to developing and implementing the utility's budget. My responsibilities include supervising Austin Water staff responsible for providing notice to our rate payers of their rates and addressing customer billing issues.



- 5. I am familiar with the SOAH Docket No. 473-15-2123.WS; PUC Docket No. 44010, the Petition of Ratepayers of the Former River Place and Wastewater Systems Appealing the Retail Water and Wastewater Rates of the City of Austin.
- 6. After reviewing Order No. 6 in that PUC/SOAH Docket, I reviewed the two notices referenced in the Order. Unfortunately, the rate schedule attached to the September 8, 2014 notice to the River Place MUD residents contains clerical errors. In the top, far right hand column of Attachment 1 to the notice (attached to my affidavit with annotations), under the headings Austin Water Utility Water Rates, Meter Charges, Nov-14, the rates that are shown are incorrect, except as to the rate for the 5/8' meter. The errors are explained below:

The former River Place customers, the Petitioners, are actually charged exactly the same retail residential rates as are all residential customers of Austin Water Utility, both those who reside inside Austin, and those who reside outside Austin's city limits. This rate is correctly stated in the September 26, 2014 notice which was sent to all other environ customers, attached to my affidavit with annotations. The notice sent to River Place MUD residents incorrectly sets out the fixed minimum charge for Commercial customers based on meter side, except as to the 5/8' meter.


8. The September 8, 2014 notice sent to River Place MUD residents simply contained mistakes in the schedule of monthly meter charges shown on Attachment 1 to the September 8, 2014 letter.

9. I have reviewed the May 18, 2015 Affidavit of Greg Meszaros with attachments. I can confirm that such attachments are a sampling of actual bills that Austin Water Utility mailed to the River Place MUD residents since November 1, 2014; as well as a sampling of actual bills mailed to residential retail (Personal information has been reacted from all sample bills) customers located outside Austin's city limits. The sampling shows that AWU does not charge the Petitioners and their neighbors water and wastewater rates which are different from other residential retail customers of Austin Water Utility residing outside Austin.
