**CITY OF AUSTIN'S FIRST REQUEST FOR DISCLOSURES TO THE STAFF OF THE
PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS**

TO: Public Utility Commission Staff, by and through their counsel of record, Jessica A. Gray and Thomas L. Tynes, Public Utility Commission of Texas, 1701 N. Congress Avenue, PO Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711.

COMES NOW, the City of Austin, in the above styled and docketed water rate appeal proceeding, pursuant to P.U.C. Proc. R. 22.141(b), and Rule 194 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, requests that Public Utility Commission Staff, provide within 20 days of service of this request, the information or material described in Rule 194.2 (a)-(l). Please note that pursuant to Texas Rules of Civil Procedure 194.5: "No objection or assertion of work product is permitted to a request under this rule [TRCP 194]."

- a. The correct names of the parties to the lawsuit.
- b. The name, address, and telephone number of any potential parties.
- c. The legal theories and, in general, the factual bases of the responding party's claims or defenses (the responding party need not marshal all evidence that may be offered at trial).
- d. The amount and any method of calculating economic damages.
- e. The name, address, and telephone number of any and all persons having knowledge of any relevant facts, and a brief statement of each identified person's connections with this case.
- f. For any testifying expert:

1. The expert's name, address, and telephone number:
2. The subject matter on which the expert will testify:
3. The general substance of the expert's mental impressions and opinions and a brief summary of the basis for them, or if the expert is not retained by, employed by, or otherwise subject to the control of the party to whom this Request is addressed, documents reflecting such information:
4. If the expert is retained by, employed by, or otherwise subject to the control of the party to whom this Request is addressed:
 - A. All documents, tangible things, reports, models, or data compilations that have been provided to, review by, or prepared by or for the experts in anticipations of the expert's testimony; and
 - B. The expert's current resume and bibliography.
- g. Any indemnity and insuring agreements.
- h. Any settlement agreements.
- i. Any witness statements.
- j. In a suit alleging physical or mental injury and damages from the occurrence that is the subject of the case, all medical records and bills that are reasonably related to the injuries or damages asserted or, in lieu thereof, an authorization permitting the disclosure of such medical records and bills.
- k. In a suit alleging physical or mental injury and damages from the occurrence that is the subject of the case, all medical records and bills obtained by the party to whom this Request is addressed by virtue of an authorization furnished by the requesting party.
- l. The name, address, and telephone number of any person who may be designated as a responsible third party.


