

**ORDER NO. 6
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED**

On December 22, 2014, Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua Texas) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Henderson County, Texas. On July 20, 2015, Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed its Recommendation on Final Disposition. Staff recommended that the Commission approve Aqua Texas' application and the proposed sale and transfer transaction.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, the sale and transfer transaction as contemplated in Aqua Texas' application may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of the transaction, Aqua Texas shall file proof that the sale and transfer transaction has been consummated and that customer deposits have been addressed. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.112(e), Aqua Texas shall have 365 days to submit proof to the Commission that the transaction has been consummated. If closing documents are not submitted within this period, or an extension granted, approval of this transaction is void. Aqua Texas is advised that there will be no change to the relevant Certificate of Convenience and Necessity until the sale and transfer transaction is complete and in accordance with Commission rules.

Beginning September 1, 2015, and continuing monthly thereafter, Aqua Texas shall file status updates regarding the sale and transfer transaction. Within thirty (30) days following the filing of Aqua Texas' proof that the sale and transfer transaction has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Staff shall file its recommendation on the adequacy of the documents.
