# SECOND NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

On February 25, 2015, in response to Order No. 3, the City of Three Rivers (Applicant) amended its application to cure deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

# I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice

On April 20, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application remains deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's April 20, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Mary Lupo and Tracy Harbour of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

# II. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Applicant's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **May 18, 2015**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

#### Order No. 4

On or before **June 17, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
