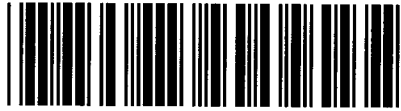

City of Three Rivers filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12642 for the provision of water utility service in Live Oak County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately **3.5 miles southwest** of downtown **Three Rivers**, Texas, and is **generally** bounded on the north **by Choke Canyon Reservoir**; on the east by **FM 1545**; on the south by **Nueces River**; and on the west by **FM 1545**.

See enclosed map of the proposed service area.

The total area being requested includes approximately **3396** acres and **37** current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.
