AMEND CCN No. 12642 PROPOSED AREA BOUNDARY

BEGINNING on the north bank of the Nueces River at the existing corner and on the eastern Boundary of CCN 12642, said corner also being the southwest corner of the PROPOSED AREA.

Boundary proceeds in a northerly direction following the present eastern boundary of CCN 12642, crossing F.M. Road 1545 at a distance of approximately 1.0 mile, and also crossing State Highway 72 at a distance of approximately 2.1 miles, boundary continues in a northerly direction for a total distance of approximately 2.3 miles to the shoreline of Choke Canyon Reservoir for a corner of CCN 12642, and also being the northwest corner of the PROPOSED AREA.

Boundary of the PROPOSED AREA will turn in an easterly direction following the shoreline meanders of Choke Canyon Reservoir a distance of approximately 1.4 miles for a corner of CCN 12642 and also being the northeast corner of the PROPOSED AREA.

Boundary will turn in a southeasterly direction following the present western boundary of CCN 12642, crossing State Highway 72 at a distance of approximately 0.4 of a mile, and continues in a southeasterly direction for a total distance of approximately 1.1 miles to an angle point for a corner of CCN 12642 and also being the most northeasterly corner of the PROPOSED AREA.

AMEND CCN No. 12642 PROPOSED AREA BOUNDARY

Boundary makes a turn to the right and proceeds in a southerly direction following the present western boundary of CCN 12642, crossing F.M. 1545 at a distance of approximately 1.2 miles, and continues in a southerly direction for a total distance of approximately 2.9 miles to the northerly bank of the Nueces River for a corner of CCN 12642, and also being the southeast corner of the PROPOSED AREA.

Boundary of the PROPOSED AREA will then follow the north bank meanders of the Nueces River in a northwesterly to southwesterly direction a distance of approximately 5.1 miles to the corner of CCN 12642 and the point of BEGINNING of the PROPOSED AREA.

The PROPOSED AREA contains approximately 3,448 acres or 5.4 square miles. The PROPOSED AREA is located in a vacant area between the existing east and west boundaries of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12642 of the City of Three Rivers. The City of Three Rivers provides water service to approximately 37 current customers in the PROPOSED AREA.

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
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
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
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 McCoy WSC (10649) 18 miles


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
