**SECOND NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
 ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

On March 2, 2015, in response to Order No. 2, the City of Garrett (Garrett) amended its application to cure deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

**I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the
 Amended Application and Notice**

On April 7, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is still deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's April 7, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Elisabeth English and Tracy Harbour of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until the discrepancies noted by Commission Staff are corrected.

II. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Garrett's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **May 8, 2015**, Garrett shall amend its

application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **June 5, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
