APPLICANT'S LIST OF PROPOSED ISSUES

Pursuant to the Order of Referral dated June 22, 2015, Laguna Vista, LTD and Laguna Tres Inc. ("Applicant") submits the following list of issues to be considered in this docket pursuant to Texas Water Code Sections 13.246(c) and 13251, and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.109 (TAC):

- 1. Whether the Applicant possesses the financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service to the requested area and any areas currently certificated to the Applicant.
- 2. The PUC may consider:
 - a. Whether the person or an affiliated interest of the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system has a history of:
 - i. Noncompliance with the requirements of the TCEQ, the commission or the Texas Department of State Health Services; or
 - ii. Continuing mismanagement or misuse of revenues as a utility service provider;
 - b. Public interest:
 - i. Whether the seller has failed to comply with a commission order;
 - ii. The adequacy of service currently provided to the requested area;
 - iii. The need for additional service in the requested area,
 - iv. The effect of approving the transaction on the utility or water supply or sewer service corporation, the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system, landowners and on any retail public utility of the same kind already serving the proximate area;
 - v. The ability of the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system to provide adequate service;
 - vi. The feasibility of obtaining service from an adjacent retail public utility:
 - vii. The financial stability of the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system, including, if applicable, the adequacy of the debt-

equity ratio of the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system if the transaction is approved;

- viii. The environmental integrity;
- ix. The probable improvement or service or lowering of cost to consumers in that area resulting from approving the transaction;
- x. The effect on the land to be included.

Applicant has not identified any issues that should not be litigated regarding retail public utility service at this time.

Applicant has not identified any legal or policy issues that need to be briefed for a preliminary order at this time.
