Dear Judge Harvel, Judge Frazee and Commission,

My family and myself live in the community Stonewater Crossing. I am an active and informed voter and it has come to my attention that Brazos Electric is in support of a 5-acre substation potentially to be located adjacent to my community.

I am in opposition of this location as there are several homes, businesses and communities near by. The Northern substation location is not habited, nor developed. My community consists of approx. 243 rooftops and there is a second community near as Frisco Lakes plans to add an additional 550 retirement homes within the same area.

The City of Little Elm has declined their opportunity to have an impact on this hearing. The landowners adjacent to the Northern substation location have declined to be a party to this hearing.

Per the Public Utility Regulatory Act 37.056 (c)(4) the Public Utility Commission is required to consider factors such as community values and aesthetics when considering an application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.
