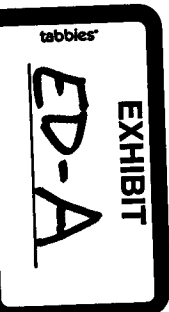
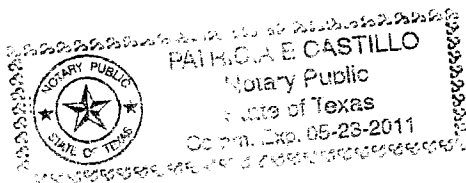

Harvest Hills Treat-
ment, LTD. has filed an
application for a CCN

Special Utility District
with the Texas Com-
mission on Environ-
mental Quality to pro-
vide sewer utility serv-
ice in Guadalupe
County.

The proposed utility
service area is located
approximately 1.8 miles
northeast of downtown
Santa Clara, Texas,
and is generally
bounded on the north
by Well Road; on the
east by Marion Road;
on the south by Young-
ford Road; and on the
west by Wetz Road.
The total area being re-
quested includes ap-
proximately 311 acres
and 35 current custom-
ers. The proposed CCN
affects customers
and/or areas located in

A request for a public
hearing must be in writ-
ing. You must state (1)
your name, mailing ad-
dress, and daytime
telephone number; (2)
the applicant's name,
application number or
another recognizable

within thirty (30) days
from the date of this
publication or notice. A
public hearing will be
held only if a legally
sufficient hearing re-
quest is received or if
the Commission on its
own motion requests a
hearing. Only those in-
dividuals who submit a
written hearing request
or a written request to
be notified if a hearing
is set will receive notice
if a hearing is sched-
uled.

If a public hearing is re-
quested, the Executive
Director will not issue
the CCN and will for-
ward the application to
the State Office of Ad-
ministrative Hearings
(SOAH) for a hearing. If
no settlement is
reached and an eviden-
tiary hearing is held, the
SOAH will submit a rec-
ommendation to the
Commission for final
decision. If an eviden-
tiary hearing is held, it
will be a legal proceed-
ing similar to a civil trial
in state district court.

If you are a landowner
with a tract of land at
least 25 acres or more,
that is partially or wholly
located within the pro-
posed area, you may
request to exclude tract
from the proposed area
(or "opt out") by provid-
ing written notice to the
Commission within (30)
days from the date that
notice was provided by
the applicant. All re-
quests to opt out of the
requested service area
must include a scaled,
general location map
and a metes and
bounds description of
the tract of land.
